STAFF REPORT

ORIGIN

Each year Council approves a Capital Expenditure Budget, a Five Year Capital Expenditure Plan, and adopts the necessary funding bylaws to finance all of the capital works.

Bill 88 has now changed the requirements of the Municipal Act, and there is now no requirement for an Annual Capital Budget. There is still the requirement for a Provisional Budget and this must be in place by December 31 of each year. The Provisional Budget is now required to be approved by bylaw as opposed to a Council resolution. The Provisional Budget must include all expenditures for the current year. There is also now a requirement for a five year financial plan, which must presented to the public for their input, and this must be completed by May 15th of each year.

ANALYSIS

The Year 2000 Provisional Budget Bylaw was adopted by Council on December 20, 1999.

The Capital Budget expenditure component totalled \$75,278,200; of this \$38,789,600 was for Year 2000 expenditures, with the balance of \$36,488,600 being the value of expenditures for prior years.

Since the passage of the Provisional Budget the staff have been reviewing the project lists, and we have determined that there are two areas that need to be amended. This total amendment equates to a \$150,000 increase in the Year 2000 Expenditures. The areas affected are the vehicle purchases for \$5,000, and the roads project, River Drive Traffic Calming measures, for \$145,000.

Although these two funding requests were not specifically included in the Year 2000 Expenditure totals, approving them will be not be a problem as the final financial plan will be adjusted accordingly to accommodate the expenditures.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The Bylaws listed below are required to provide the funding authorizations to finance the various capital projects. The financing requirements are well within the existing reserve expenditure policies and funding availability. The total for each bylaw is detailed below.

BYLAW NO. 7080

DEVELOPMENT COST CHARGES RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW, 2000

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 933(1) of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, the City of Richmond imposes Development Cost Charges;

AND WHEREAS the City of Richmond has, pursuant to Section 935 placed all Development Cost Charges in separate special Development Cost Charge Reserve Funds established for the appropriate purposes;

AND WHEREAS the City of Richmond, pursuant to Sections 935 and 936(6), wishes to use a portion of the money deposited for the purposes for which it was deposited, namely:

- (a) to pay the capital costs of providing, constructing, altering or expanding sewage, water, drainage and highway facilities, other than off-street parking facilities and park land acquisition that relate, directly or indirectly, to the development in respect of which the charge was collected, or
- (b) to pay principal and interest on a debt incurred as a result of an expenditure referred to in paragraph (a), or
- (c) to use interest earned on money in the Park Land Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund to provide for fencing, landscaping, drainage and irrigation, restrooms and changing rooms, playground and playing field equipment on park land owned by the local government or owned by the Crown and managed by the local government;

NOW THEREFORE the City of Richmond in open meeting assembled, enacts as

follows:

- 1. The sum of \$15,024,530.00 is hereby authorized to be withdrawn from the special Development Cost Charge Reserve Funds.
- 2. The said \$15,024,530.00 shall be used for the projects set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw, and the said \$15,024,530.00 shall be withdrawn from the special Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund as specified in Schedule "A".
- 3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund.

- 4. That the 1999 Development Cost Charges Expenditure Bylaw No. 6992 be herewith repealed in its entirety.
- 5. This Bylaw may be cited as "Development Cost Charges Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw No. 7080".
