Staff Report

Origin

It was recently discovered that there was an omission in the Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw No. 7094. While the bylaw created the violation of parking a vehicle "in an area that is not designated a parking area" (section 3.3.1(b)), there was no designation of the fine applicable to this violation. Accordingly, valid violation tickets could not be issued for this violation. Other enforcement measures, such as issuing summons, were not impacted by this omission.

Analysis

The Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw needs to be amended to provide for the fine to be applied to section 3.3.1(b).

Financial Impact

Nil.

Conclusion

The Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw needs to be amended to specify the fine applicable to the violation set out in subsection 3.3.1(b).

**Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw No. 7094,
Amendment Bylaw No. 7322**

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

1. Subsection 8.2.1 is amended by adding the following as clause (d):
 - (d) clauses (i) or (ii) of subsection 3.3.1(b) is liable for the fine specified in Level II of Schedule B
2. Schedule B is amended by adding bylaw subsection 3.3.1(b) under the heading "Level II – Other Offences".
3. This Bylaw is cited as "**Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw No. 7094, Amendment Bylaw No. 7322**".
