

CONSENT AGENDA

2008 GVWD Capital Projects

Approved

The Board approved the list of projects outlined in Attachment 1 of the report "2008 GVWD Capital Projects" for implementation in 2008.

2007 Phase-Out Payment in Lieu of Property Taxes

Approved

The Board approved the payment of a phase-out grant in lieu of taxes to member municipalities totaling approximately \$518,000 and will request that the Province of BC allow the 2007 payment as a phase-out grant in lieu of property taxes.

Village of Belcarra Membership in the GVWD

Approved

The Board approved the addition of the Village of Belcarra as a member of the Greater Vancouver Water District subject to the following conditions:

- The Village of Belcarra will enter into a legally binding agreement with the District of North Vancouver, in a form satisfactory to the Commissioner, for the supply of GVWD water from the District of North Vancouver water system.
- Belcarra will enter into an Entry Agreement with the GVWD on terms and conditions satisfactory to the Commissioner.
- Belcarra will confirm the Entry Agreement by bylaw.

The Board authorized the Commissioner to execute an Entry Agreement with the Village of Belcarra on behalf of the GVWD.

Non-Refillable 15 Litre Water Containers

Approved

The Board will request that the Minister of Environment ban the sale of large non-refillable polyethylene terephthalate (PET) containers. A representative from Metro Vancouver will meet with the Minister of the Environment to outline the region's priority needs for waste reduction initiatives, and/or invite the Minister to come to meet with the Waste Management Committee or the Board.

- (c) The design and delivery of a community outreach initiative in partnership with member municipalities to demonstrate the benefits and opportunities of promoting increased density and diversity as a means of providing an expanded range of modest cost housing.

Future of the Region Sustainability Dialogues: Drugs and Crime - Dealing with your drug problem
