The General Purposes Committee, at its meeting held on Monday, February 5th, 2001, considered the attached report, and recommends as follows:

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

That the grants (identified in the report dated December 17th, 2000, from the Manager, Customer Services):

- (1) for Health and Social Services applicants be awarded and the cheques disbursed for a total of \$248,200; and
- (2) for Cultural, Community Promotions and Summer Programs applicants be awarded and the cheques disbursed for a total of \$68,300,

and that the Health, Socials Services & Others and the Cultural, Community Promotions and Summer Programs components of the 2001 Grant Applications be amended to redistribute the \$3,500 grant to the Richmond Mother and Child Care Society to:

- (a) the Richmond Committee on Disability and the Richmond Therapeutic Equestrian Society in the amount of \$1,500 each; and:
- (b) the Sea Island Community Association in the amount of \$500.

STAFF REPORT

ORIGIN

City Council has the authority for providing financial assistance to community organizations under the Local Government Act. The City of Richmond Grants Policy (Policy 3705 – Attachment 1) outlines the principles and processes by which the grants are to be allocated.

A Staff Grants Review Committee (Mr. Kari Huhtala and Ms. Anne Stevens) has reviewed the applications and recommends the allocations before you.

ANALYSIS

Advertisements were placed in the local newspapers advising the community of the grant process. Those who requested applications received them. The closing date for all applications was Friday October 13,2000.

This year there were a total of fifty (50) applicants. Of the 50 applicants, one came in after the October 13,2000 deadline. The organization that was late in applying was Community Arts Council. Staff has not recommended any funding for this year.

Another five organizations that applied for 2001 Grants also applied in 2000 under Category 2. In the policy, Category 2 applicants who receive funding would not be eligible for funding for two subsequent years. The five organizations, which fall in this category, are:

- Women's Resource Centre;
- Richmond Family Childcare
- Richmond Christmas Hamper Fund.
- Richmond Weavers and Spinners
- Sea Island Community Association

Staff is recommending they be denied funding for the 2001-Year Grants so as not to compromise the integrity of the system.

There were a number of applicants that received funding last year but did not apply for a 2001 grant. Those agencies are:

- Canadian Guide Dogs for the Blind
- > Canadian Red Cross Prevention Service
- > Richmond Society for Community Living
- Richmond Citizen's Crime Watch
- Richmond Youth Orchestra Society

The remaining 42 applicants were reviewed and of the 42 there were 13 new applicants. Those applicants were:

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The attached summary sheets show that the total grant funding for 2001 was \$316,500. This is comprised of Health, Social Services and Other at \$248,200 and Cultural and Community/Summer Programs at \$68,300. The year 2001 budget has the appropriate funding level to meet these grant recommendations

CONCLUSION

The City Grants program is a way for the City to provide funding and assistance to organizations that provide required services to various residents of Richmond and who also meet the policy criteria. The number of applications increased this year and, as always, far exceeds the recommended allotment.

POLICY 3705:

It is Council policy that:

The principles on which grant funding will be approved are as follows:

A. GENERAL PRINCIPLES:

The City of Richmond supports the enhancement of a positive quality of life for all its residents, and the Council recognizes that one method of helping to achieve this goal is through an annual grants program.

Applications from non-profit or registered charitable organizations and/or groups are eligible for a City grant on the basis that they:

- offer projects, programs, services or events which have a demonstrated need in the community;
- provide the greatest benefits to the largest number of Richmond residents;
- exercise co-ordination and co-operation with other groups to prevent duplication of projects, programs, services or events;
- provide evidence of having sought funding from a variety of sources;
- promote volunteer participation and citizen involvement;
- apply a "user pay" philosophy, where applicable;
- use innovative approaches and techniques in addressing community issues:
- provide documentation supporting the financial need for funding, including, but not limited, to the current financial statements of the applicant;
- show real and financial need, and demonstrate the impact that would occur following non-funding from the City;

and on the understanding, that:

- Not all organizations meeting these general principles will automatically receive a grant or grant increase.
- Approval of a grant by the City in any particular year should not be viewed as an automatic ongoing source of annual funding. Grant renewals are not automatic,

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nor is any increase in funds. Grant approvals in a particular year, do not guarantee that grant requests in subsequent years will be successful.

Only one application per year will be accepted per organization.

B. DEFINITIONS OF ELIGIBLE GRANT CATEGORIES:

1. Category 1 and Category 2 Applicants – Applicable category for any application to be determined by Council.

Applicants may apply for Category 1 or Category 2 designation as follows:

<u>Category 1</u> applicants must be deemed to be providing unique and essential services to the community of Richmond. Applicants must demonstrate how their services fit under this designation. Applicants who are deemed to be Category 1 may apply for funding in subsequent years; and

<u>Category 2</u> applicants who receive funding would not be eligible to apply or receive funding for two subsequent years.

2. Operating Assistance

Regular operating expenses or core budgets of established organizations, including supplies and equipment, heat, light, telephone, photocopying, rent, and administrative support salaries.

3. Projects

One-time-only projects which respond to health, social and cultural needs within Richmond, must have a specific set of goals and objectives, and have a defined start and finish date.

4. Programs and Services

Ongoing programs and services which contribute to the health and social well-being of Richmond residents, or which contribute to the general interest and advantage of the City.

5. Events (Community Promotion)

Events which enhance and contribute to the cultural life of Richmond, which promote community involvement and spirit, and which have a defined start and finishing date (but may also be held annually), and which promote Richmond outside the City.

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6. Council Discretion

Council may, at its discretion, award grants to groups which offer a service deemed by Council to be of value to the City, or to community committees whose mandate is to function for the good of the City and its residents.

C. EXCLUSIONS FROM ELIGIBILITY FOR CITY GRANT:

- ' Applications from individuals
- Activities which are restricted to people of specific religious or ethnic groups
- Annual fund-raising campaigns, form letter requests or telephone campaigns
- Building funds or capital construction campaigns
- Debt retirement
- Expenses related to attendance at seminars, workshops, symposiums, or conferences
- Agencies which primarily fund other organizations

D. GRANTS REVIEW CONSIDERATIONS

Not all organizations meeting the criteria will automatically receive a grant. Grant allocations are dependent on the Grants budget established by City Council.

In reviewing grant applications and preparing recommendations for grant allocations, Council may give primary consideration to the following factors:

- Basic eligibility and demonstrates organizational efficiency, effectiveness and stability.
- numbers of Richmond residents served
- quality of service
- financial need of the organization
- community interaction
- role and number of volunteers
- use of existing community services and facilities
- local input into governance
