EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW, 2000

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Equipment Reserve Fund established pursuant to the <u>Municipal Act</u> of \$7,189,074.17 as at January, 20 2000, which amount has been calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the said monies to meet the cost of various equipment purchases as set out in Schedule "A";

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Richmond, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The sum of \$3,519,600.00 is hereby appropriated from the Equipment Reserve Fund to finance the acquisitions set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw.
- 2. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
- 3. That the 1999 Equipment Reserve Expenditure Bylaw No. 6993 be herewith repealed in its entirety.
