Now I wish to set up this meeting with the General Purpose Committee to see if this matter can be cleared up.

Mr. Bruce told me to explain the circumstances leading up to this and also what outcome I would like. I would very much like to have this late charge reversed due to very extenuating circumstances. If you go through my file on this property you will see that I have never failed to be on time and with the full amount.
