I look forward to building on our relationship through sharing ideas and concerns when we meet.

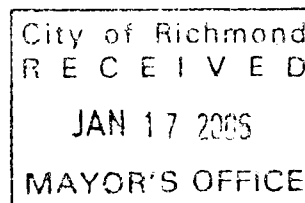
