ORIGIN

In accordance with the requirements of the *Local Government Act*, this report has been prepared for Council, showing the candidates for whom an election campaign disclosure statement was not filed by the deadline of February 13th, 2002 or by the late filing deadline of March 15th, 2002.

ANALYSIS

Of the 29 total number of persons who were candidates for the offices of Mayor and Councillor, the following three persons failed to file by February 13th, 2002:

- (a) Renata Steele;
- (b) Robert Bessler; and
- (c) Janet Sinclair.

Ms. Sinclair did file by the March 15th, 2002 extended deadline and paid the \$500 fee to the general revenue of the City and is entitled to run as a candidate in the general local election in November. However, the names of Renata Steele and Robert Bessler must be forwarded to the Inspector of Municipalities, to be included in a public list of all persons in British Columbia who are disqualified from running in the November general local election.
