**Re:** Notice of Motion Regarding Council's Position on Expanded Gaming

This is to advise you that Councillor Kumagai has served a Notice of Motion to rescind a resolution (Resolution No. R98/16-10 from the regular Council meeting of September 14, 1998) that re-affirms, and communicates to the Provincial government, Council's position that the city does not support the expansion of gaming within its jurisdiction. Because this Notice of Motion was received in accordance with the Council Procedure Bylaw, this matter will be on the agenda of the regular Council Meeting of April 8, 2002.

The procedure to rescind a resolution is that after the rescission motion is seconded, the Mayor must ask the server of the Notice of Motion (Councillor Kumagai) to state his reasons for this action. Reasons must be provided by the server or the Notice of Motion is deemed to have been withdrawn. The motion is not delegable, however, it may be tabled, amended, or referred. If the motion to rescind the previous decision is carried, then Council would be free to propose an alternative motion.
