#### **Staff Report**

#### Origin

The provincial Liquor Control and Licencing Branch (LCLB) issues licences under the authority of the Liquor Control and Licencing Act and Regulations.

The LCLB, rather than the applicant, now notifies local government to give them the opportunity to provide comments and recommendations to the LCLB on all liquor licence applications.

This report will deal with the application from JP Malone's requesting an extension of hours.

#### Analysis

JP Malone's has applied to the Province to extend their hours of operations Sunday through Thursday until 2:30 a.m., and Friday and Saturday until 3:30 a.m. This would be a **permanent** request.

JP Malone's presently has a temporary permit which expires the end of April 2004.

The Provincial Liquor Licencing process requires the City to provide resolution based on the comments received from the residents and agencies in the City.

The public process required the posting of a sign notifying the public of the application for a minimum of thirty days; three advertisements placed in the local paper and letters sent to residents within 50 metres of the establishment requesting their comments on the extension of hours for JP Malone's. The thirty-day time frame lapsed April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2004.

Since the introduction of the new Provincial Liquor regulations, Council has expressed a strong concern against extension of hours for liquor establishments in Richmond and based on the information received from the public; RCMP and the Health Department, staff recommend that the request for extension of hours by JP Malone's be denied for the following reasons:

- Increase in police manpower, which is an additional cost to the City. Police resources do not exist to deal with the extension of hours and the negative impact extended hours has on the community.
- 97% of the residents who responded are opposed to the extension of hours. This does not include the petition from JP Malone's as it is suggested that petitions not be accepted as they would give the impression of bias.

 Negative impact on both the residential and commercial residents as shown in the letters from the residents.

- Increase in vandalism and litter which will be an additional cost to the City and the commercial area affected.
- Increase in late night noise and disturbances.
- Increase in car noise and speeding.
- This is a neighbourhood setting, as stated by a number of residents and is not conducive to late night bar hours.
- Potential for increase in violence, as stated in the police comments.

To Whom it May Concern,

Re.: Notice of application to extend hours of sale at JP Malones Pub by Mr. J. Grewal.

I wish to express my disapproval with this application for the following reasons:

1) At present, drunken, rowdy patrons of the pub spill out onto the streets and yell, disturbing nearby residents. Loud music also emanates from the pub until it closes, making it difficult to sleep some nights. Expanding the pub operating hours would simply extend the number of hours that nearby residents are exposed to this noisy disturbance.

All residents have the right to enjoy their home without the disturbance of noisy, rowdy pub patrons roaming the streets in the early hours of the morning. This application is not conducive towards this end.

Our complex has experienced damage to our property, such as our exterior lights, sprinkler heads, and planters, resulting in extra costs that all owners must bear. It is reasonable to assume that some of this property damage is caused by drunken patrons exiting the pub. Expanding the pub hours will increase patrons' drinking time, resulting in the potential for more disorderly behaviour and further damage to our complex.

Residents should not have to bear the costs of others willfully damaging our property.

For the above reasons, this application will not serve local residents well. It will contribute to the inability of local residents to enjoy their homes, as well as further property damage and ensuing costs. This application should not be approved.

Their patio enclosure is made of plastic and does nothing to contain the loud music, which makes it especially difficult to sleep on weekday nights until 2:30 am The parking is not adequate which causes people and cars to spill out into the otherwise quiet streets at 3:30am. This late night closing promotes an undesirable downtown atmosphere in Richmond, is this what we want in our communities?

I am writing to you today to express my opposition in regards to the application by JP Malone's Pub located at 9031 Blundell Road, Richmond BC to amend their current operating hours.

I am extremely concerned about the effect this will have on our urban neighborhood and our community as a whole.

Currently, I encounter a very high volume of noise and disturbance emitting from the pub(indoor and outdoor seating), as well as the outflow of their customers onto the street after closing time(yelling/rowdiness/cars speeding away down the road). Numerous times during the year the volume in the pub is so loud that I have to close my windows to block out both the music and the noise of the customers in the pub as I attempt to get a decent nights sleep before I have to get up for work the next morning.

I am writing to express my opposition to the above application. My husband and I purchased a townhome at 7733 Turnill Street in August 2003. Our intent was to buy into a quiet family neighborhood in order to raise our 8 year old son and our second child, due in April. Our expectations for our new home and community have been met, with one exception. Since January, when Malone's began staying open until 3 am, I have been awakened every weekend morning between 2 and 3 by the excessive noise of patrons leaving the pub. Shouting, singing, car door slamming, engine revving, horn honking, and car alarms have become routine for at least a one-half hour period, every single weekend. My next-door neighbor has complained of the same. Although signs are posted outside the pub asking patrons to respect nearby residents, and stating that noise will not be tolerated, it is clear that the signs are ineffective, and that nothing is being done to curb the excessive noise. This intrusion into my otherwise quiet home is becoming intolerable, and therefore I am strongly opposed to the possibility of having similar disruptions every day of the week, if extended sales are permitted.

While I understand that Malone's existed prior to the construction of the new townhouses in the area, the fact is that where there were once a half-dozen single family homes, there are now well over 100 families living within earshot of this pub, and more townhouse developments are planned even closer to the pub. The City of Richmond has made a decision to increase the density of this neighborhood, and therefore the City also bears the responsibility of ensuring that all subsequent decisions are consistent with the needs of these new communities. Clearly, allowing extended liquor sales in a dense residential neighborhood is not consistent with the goal of creating safe, peaceful, liveable communities.

I urge the City to consider the greater good of the community in reviewing this application. I cannot think of a single benefit that extended hours of liquor sales would offer to the surrounding community. The desire of a single business to increase profits must not come at the expense of hundreds of families who have a right to the quiet and peaceful enjoyment of their homes.

We, concerned residents of Blundell Gardens located at 8760 Blundell Road, are writing with respect to the late night openings at JP Malone's Bar and Grill located at the corner of Garden City and Blundell Roads, Richmond, B.C.

We understand that since January 01, 2004 "Malone's" has had late night openings until 3:00 am. This has resulted in unacceptable levels of noise late at night, rowdy behaviour by patrons with police vehicles often in attendance as well as the incumbent late night traffic. The karoke can often be heard well after 2:00 a.m. The level of noise is so increased since the inception of the late night openings, that even suites on the south facing side of our premises (which face onto Palmer School), cannot leave their windows open at night. We have had complaints of lack of sleep, of residents in suites on the north side of the building having drunken (and unwell) patrons of the pub loitering on the front of our premises.
