
Origin

Council approval for the following discharge of right of way is required:

Property Affected:	12311 No. 2 Road
Right of Way to be D/C:	Underground right of way for public utilities, never utilized by the City. Plan 55839 Charge No. RD86670
Reason for Discharge:	Rights of way are being reconfigured during redevelopment of the site. The City will take a new right of way over utility works to be established on site and has taken additional rights for public right of passage (walkway across the rear of the site). There is no net loss of right of way asset to the City.
Financial Implications:	No cost to the City.
Legal Description:	Lot B Section 12 Block 3 North Range 7 West New Westminster District Plan BCP18570 (PID: 026-334-089)
