Comments:	<p>We are very concerned about the proposal to subdivide four lots (6611, 6631, 6671 and 6691 Blundell Road) to build 11 single family lots. We believe that the huge increase in the number of homes will increase noise, traffic and pollution in our residential neighbourhood. Of particular concern is the proposal to create a "back lane" access road leading off Curzon Road. This would cause a great many cars to enter and exit from Curzon, very near homes on Curzon and Chelmsford. We feel that this would be a dangerous situation and would negatively affect the quality of life in our residential neighbourhood. Any subdivision of these properties should make provision for their vehicular access from their Blundell Road frontage, and not through others' back yards. Thank you.
