

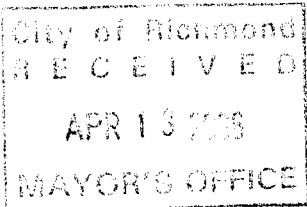

Dear Mayor Brodie,

On behalf of the JCC Maccabi Games, thank you for meeting with us April 4, 2006. It was helpful to have an opportunity to update the City of Richmond on the status of the upcoming games. We are delighted with your acceptance of our invitation to attend the Opening Ceremonies and VIP Reception August 13th 5:00pm – 9:00pm as a special guest of the games. We look forward to receiving confirmation from your office of your intention to attend.

As related at our meeting, the Maccabi Games are not intended to be a one week party. The Jewish Community Centre of Greater Vancouver has invested a great deal of resources including a \$2.2 million budget to provide a lasting infrastructure composed of 50+ trained personal, an army of 1000 trained volunteers, 350 local athletes and coaches and multiple relationships with corporate, government, and various foundations. All of this, plus the development of community good will, is to ensure a JCC Maccabi Games legacy. While we appreciate the City of Richmond's helpful support through the office of Dave Semple, your visible presence at special events and the city's name on our Maccabi stationary, our request for assistance with expenses relates to venue, facility and maintenance charges continues to be an issue. The City's financial support would go a long way in achieving the realization of the Games. To that end, I ask serious consideration be given to waiving or significantly reducing the costs of renting Watermania, Minoru hockey facility and various other field usages. The JCC Maccabi Games embodies the spirit and the intention of the City of Richmond to support community, youth and healthy living. The City's support as a sponsor would be appropriately recognized, along with the Province of BC's \$100,000 support, on our web site, signage and in various printed materials including our Souvenir and Guide books. Additionally there will be the opportunity for political exposure at various events during the week of the Games.

Another area discussed during our meeting involved your recommendation to do a presentation to the City's Parks and Recreation Committee in order to provide them with an understanding of the benefits as well as the scope

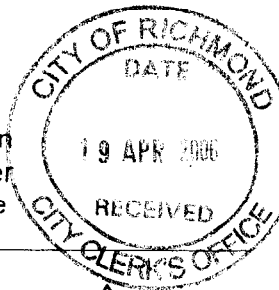
