- A Design-Build contract was submitted to Structure Craft for the wood roof system.
- A revised Budget Cost Plan was prepared in accordance with the new construction estimate and the revised list of grants.
- A revised Landscape plan was prepared.
- Construction of River Road continued with anticipated completion in October 2006.
- TP #4 Piling was issued for tender.
- TP #7c Hollow Core Slabs was issued for tender.
- Obtain final sign-off of revised floor layouts and Room Data Sheets by the Programming Team.
- Council considered funding the Oval Precinct Art Plan.
