Origin

Rupinder Singh Rocky Mangat started his employment with the City of Richmond as a Bylaw Liaison Officer I for the purposes of bylaw enforcement on May 18, 2006.

Jamie Rodgers started his employment with the City of Richmond as a Bylaw Liaison Officer I for the purposes of bylaw enforcement on May 23, 2006.

Both are assuming existing budgeted positions on a temporary Full-Time basis due to a long-term absence and a temporary re-assignment of other Officers.

Analysis

In the discharge of their normal duties, it is appropriate to provide the new Bylaw Liaison Officers the ability to issue both Municipal Ticket Information and Parking Bylaw Violations.


Under provisions of the Offence Act, for the purposes of the issuance of a violation ticket and / or service of summons in respect of an alleged offence under a bylaw of a Municipality, a Peace Officer includes Bylaw Enforcement Officers as appointed under the Police Act.

It is recommended that Council authorize the appointment of Rupinder Singh Rocky Mangat and Jamie Rodgers as Bylaw Enforcement Officers in accordance with Section 36 of the Police Act, for the purposes of the service of a summons and the issuance of tickets under the authority of Bylaw No. 7321 – Municipal Ticket Information Authorization.
