"WHEREAS the City of Richmond is one of the municipal members of TransLink;

AND WHEREAS the Coalition of HandyDART Users has recently issued a report entitled "Engaging the Future" (2005) regarding the management of the HandyDART system by TransLink;

AND WHEREAS the report "Engaging the Future" (2005) discusses six key areas the Coalition of HandyDART Users have identified as problems and/or inefficiencies in the current system;

AND WHEREAS those six key problem areas identified include short-term contracts, multiple zones and multiple contractors, stifling technological innovation, service not meeting demand, facilities and drivers for vehicles, and a lack of vision.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, Richmond City Council:

- 1. Call on TransLink to review the report by the Coalition of HandyDART Users entitled "Engaging the Future" (2005);
- 2. Call on TransLink to continue to consult with the Coalition of HandyDART Users, including implementing the findings of their report entitled "Engaging the Future" (2005).
- 3. Communicate this resolution to TransLink and the Coalition of HandyDART Users."
