#### **Staff Report**

#### Origin

In November 2002, staff brought forward a report to the Public Works and Transportation Committee recommending that applications for ten projects be submitted to the Canada/British Columbia Infrastructure Program. The technical staff at the Ministry of Community, Aboriginal and Women's Services (MCAWS) has indicated that the Canada/British Columbia Infrastructure Program does not fund projects involving leased lands.

#### **Analysis**

Staff have submitted outlines for the ten projects with the priorities for the projects ranked from six to fifteen. The first five priority rankings for projects have already been awarded.

During the application process, staff has been in contact with the technical staff at the MCAWS who administer the Canada/BC Infrastructure Program on behalf of the federal and provincial governments. The technical staff at MCAWS has indicated that the East Richmond Branch Library application with a municipal priority ranking 9 should be withdrawn from the Canada/BC Infrastructure Program since the Program does not typically provide funding to projects on leased land.

Staff has reviewed the applications and recommend that the application for the East Richmond Branch Library be withdrawn from the Canada/BC Infrastructure Program.
