## Local Improvement Reserve Expenditure Bylaw No. 7379

Whereas as at May 29, 2002, the following unappropriated balances exist in the reserve funds established under the provisions of the *Local Government Act*:

Local Improvement Reserve Fund - balance as at December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2001 (audited) \$3,495,065 - transactions since January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2002 \$4,034

BALANCE in Reserve Fund at May 29, 2002 **\$3,499,099** 

Now therefore, the Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

- 1. The sum of \$750,000 is appropriated from the Local Improvement Reserve Fund to finance capital works as approved in the 2002 Capital Budget.
- 2. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the authorized expenditures have been made, such balances must be returned to the credit of the applicable reserve funds.
- 3. This Bylaw is cited as "Local Improvement Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw No. 7379".
