STAFF REPORT

<u>ORIGIN</u>

Section 327 of the Local Government Act requires a municipality to adopt a 5 Year Financial Plan bylaw annually before May 15th. This bylaw includes the City's operating, utilities and capital budgets and once it is adopted by Council, it can be amended at any time. The 5 Year Financial Plan bylaw provides Council with the authority to undertake expenditures, while the Statutory Reserve Fund Expenditure bylaws provide Council with the authority to access statutory reserves to fund capital projects approved under the 5 Year Financial Plan.

ANALYSIS

The 2001 Capital Budget totals \$37,956,400 of which \$35,687,400 is being funded through the Statutory Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaws as noted below. The difference of \$2,269,000 is comprised of:

- 1. Funding from non-City sources such as grants and developer contributions for some Roads projects (total = \$1,119,000) and a sanitary sewer project (total = \$400,000)
- 2. Funding for Local Improvement projects (total = \$750,000) where a Statutory Reserve Fund Expenditure bylaw has not been approved until the relevant projects have been clearly determined

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The Bylaws listed below are required to provide the funding authorizations to finance various 2001 capital projects. The financing requirements are well within the existing reserve expenditure policies and funding availability. The total for each Bylaw is detailed below:
