





Staff Report

Origin

Section 2 (2) and (3) of the Financial Information Act stipulates that a municipality must prepare the following "Statement of Financial Information" within six months after the end of each fiscal year. Further, Section 9(2) of the Financial Information Regulation also requires that the statement be approved by its council and by the officer assigned responsibility for financial administration under the Local Government Act.

- a statement of assets and liabilities;
- an operational statement;
- a schedule of debts;
- a schedule of guarantee and indemnity agreements;
- a schedule showing remuneration and expenses paid in respect of each employee (Appendix I) ;
- a schedule showing payments made for provision of goods or services (Appendix II) .

Analysis

The current prescribed amounts for purposes of reporting as stipulated in the Financial Information Regulation for employee remuneration/expenses and payments to suppliers are \$75,000 and \$25,000 respectively.

A statement including schedules which shows employee earnings in excess of \$75,000 and related expenses for the 2002 Year is attached in Appendix I.

A statement listing payments to suppliers for goods and services in excess of \$25,000 for the 2002 Year is attached in Appendix II.


The remaining schedules referred in the Statement of Financial Information are included in the City's 2002 Annual Report.
