


STAFF RECOMMENDATION

STAFF REPORT

ORIGIN

Tamara Bissett started her temporary full time employment with the City of Richmond as a Parking Patroller for the purposes of bylaw enforcement, on July 22, 2003. The officer will be trained, equipped, and commence enforcement duties upon completion of training.

ANALYSIS

Under the provisions of the Offence Act, for the purposes of the service of a summons in respect of an alleged offence under a bylaw of a Municipality, a Peace Officer includes Bylaw Enforcement Officer appointed under the Police Act.

The officer will be regularly patrolling for metered, time restricted areas in our community, as well as safety related offences.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

CONCLUSION

It is recommended that Council authorise the appointment of Tamara Bissett as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer in accordance with Section 36 of the Police Act, for the purposes of the service of a summons and the issuing of tickets under the authority of Bylaw No. 7139.
