## STAFF REPORT

At the Council Meeting on July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2003, Council cancelled the August Public Hearing and referred four bylaws which received first reading on that date to a Public Hearing to be held in conjunction with the August 25<sup>th</sup> Regular Council Meeting. Since then, the General Purposes Committee has recommended one more bylaw for first reading and Public Hearing. Furthermore, three bylaws were deleted from the July Public Hearing because of technical problems and referred to a Public Hearing in August. Thus, a total of eight bylaws and an amendment to a Lot Size Policy are due for consideration in August. It would not be advisable to hold public hearings on all of these matters in conjunction with the August 25<sup>th</sup> Regular Council Meeting, and thus I recommend that the August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2003 Regular Council Meeting for Public Hearings be reinstituted.
