Staff Report

Origin

The current Animal Control & Shelter Services contract with the BCSPCA expires on December 31, 2003. Clause 3.02 of the contract allows the City and the BCSPCA, by mutual agreement, to renew the current contract for a further two years under existing conditions and financial obligations.

Staff are currently in discussion with the BCSPCA with regard to service delivery models and are discussing internally other service delivery options.

By mutual agreement the BCSPCA is willing to extend the Animal Control and Shelter Services contract on a month-to-month basis, until service delivery options and contract negotiations have been completed.
