**Additional Hotel Room Tax Imposition Bylaw No. 7810**

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant Governor in Council is hereby requested to issue a regulation under Section 43(2)(e) of the *Hotel Room Tax Act* which extends the existing date of October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2004 to which Section 2.1 of the said Act applies in respect of accommodation purchased within the City of Richmond.
2. The tax to be imposed under the provisions of the regulation is requested to be two percent of the purchase price of the accommodation.
3. The funds paid to the City of Richmond under provisions of the regulation shall be applied to tourist promotion, projects, programs and development of a Trade and Exhibition Centre.
4. This bylaw is cited as “**Additional Hotel Room Tax Imposition Bylaw No. 7810**”.
