Dr. and Mrs. Geoffrey Webb, 3300 No. 6 Road, addressed Council regarding the proposed non-conforming use (cat kennel) on the property at 3380 No. 6 Road. A copy of their submission is on file in the City Clerk's Office.

Item No. 14 – Residents' Proposal to Change the Name of Granville Avenue to Quilchena Drive West of Barnard Drive

Mr Barry Muis, 3508 Granville Avenue, voiced concern about a number of statements made in the staff report, and in particular about (i) the City's policy on road naming, (ii) the concerns of Canada Post about difficulties which could be experienced in the delivery of mail, and (iii) the issues raised by emergency services. He urged Council to allow the residents sufficient time to undertake a new survey of the residents in the affected area to re-address the issues raised in the report.

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Bob Light, 10751 Palmberg Road, addressed the above three reports – with respect to Item 12, Mr. Light stated that the wording of Part (1)(b) of the recommendation implied that the development of the site as a Canadian Tire store was a foregone conclusion, even though the rezoning of the property had not yet been completed.

With reference to Item 23, he questioned when No. 5 Road in the area of the temple was to be closed, as the date was not shown in the staff recommendation.

With reference to Item 25, Mr. Light questioned if the staff report provided information on the cost of acquiring and developing the Odlinwood property.

Item No. 16 – Application for Non-farm Use for the purposes of operating a cat kennel – Carol Richert, Richmond Homeless Cats, 3380 No. 6 Road

Carol Richert, 8951 Saunders Road, advised that the trailer presently on the property was to be relocated to a site further back on the property, which would result in that structure being almost 480 feet away from Dr. Webb's property. Ms. Richert also commented on statements made by Dr. Webb about feral cats and the operation of the Richmond Homeless Cats Society.

June Humphreys, 9560 Herbert Road, further addressed the concerns raised by Dr. Webb. She indicated that any sick or injured cats would be tended to at a proper veterinary facility, and that the proposed location on No. 6 Road would be used as an adoption facility only.
