#### Staff Report

#### Origin

At the General Purposes Committee meeting on December 3, 2001 staff were directed to establish a procedure that would facilitate an annual review of business licence fees and associated costs surrounding the delivery of the service.

#### **Analysis**

In recent years the City has seen a variety of increases in the cost of issuing business licences and in providing ongoing enforcement of the Business Licence and Business Regulation Bylaws. Some of these costs include:

- salaries and basic overhead expenses,
- . upgrades and replacements of outdated equipment,
- . the addition of new regulations to enforcement responsibilities,
- recent partnerships with the Community and Safety Division, in particular the RCMP, which have led to increased off-hours enforcement; and
- reduced or eliminated resources through senior levels of government including: the Provincial Health Unit, Liquor Control Branch and Motor Carrier Branch (now ICBC) which have led to increased responsibilities for municipal licencing departments.

In addition to reviewing the costs associated with business licence enforcement and administration, current fees charged were reviewed in a regional context to determine the Citys competitive position. A recent survey of business licence fees charged by comparative municipalities showed Richmond consistently ranked amongst the lowest in all major categories.

The following table details the survey results.

In light of the increase in the cost of service provision and the fact that the City of Richmond currently charges amongst the lowest business licence fees in the region, staff are recommending an increase of 3%, rounded up to the nearest whole dollar, to all business licences effective December 1, 2002.

#### **Financial Impact**

The City will realize increased revenues of approximately \$66,000 for the licence year of 2003.

#### Conclusion

The proposed amendment to Business Licence Bylaw No.7360 and the resulting business licence fee increase will more accurately reflect the costs associated with the service provided while minimizing the impact on local businesses.

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 7360 is amended by deleting Schedule A and Schedule B in their entirety and replacing them with the following:

#### VEHICLE FOR HIRE BUSINESSES

- 1. Each Vehicle for Hire applicant must pay:
  - (a) an office licence fee of \$106; and
  - (b) the following per vehicle Licence Fee, based on number of vehicles;

CLASS "A" Taxicab	\$97
CLASS "B" Limousine	\$65
CLASS "C" Sightseeing Taxicab	\$97
CLASS "D" Airport Taxicab	\$97
CLASS "E" Private Bus	\$97
CLASS "I" Charter Minibus	\$97
CLASS "J" Rental Vehicle	
Group 1	\$11
Group 2	\$65
CLASS "K" Driver Training Vehicle	\$48
CLASS "M" Tow-Truck	\$97

- 2. Notwithstanding the per-vehicle licence fees stipulated in Section 1, the maximum licence fee for any Vehicle for Hire business is \$3,090.
- 3. The fee for transferring a Vehicle for Hire Licence within any calendar year is \$36.
- 4. The fee for replacing a Vehicle for Hire Licence plate or decal is \$10.

#### SCHEDULE B to BYLAW NO. 7360

- 1. The fee for transferring a licence from one person to another, or for issuing a new licence because of a change in information on the face of such licence, except a change between licence categories or subcategories, is \$36.
- 2. The fee for changing the category or subcategory of a licence is either:
  - (a) \$36; or
  - (b) the difference between the **licencee's** existing fee and the fee for the proposed category or subcategory,

whichever is the greater.

2. This Bylaw is cited as "Business Licence Bylaw No. 7360, Amendment Bylaw No. 7432".
