Staff Report

Origin

This project is part of the 2003 Capital Program as approved by Council.

Background

The total project includes the tenant improvements to the leased premises at Unit 150, 11590 Cambie Road, renovations to Brighouse Library in order to achieve operating efficiencies, and library equipment. The total approved funding available for all three of these components is \$1,100,000.

Tender Results

This tender, T.1557 was for the Cambie Branch Tenant Improvements component.

The City received seven (7) tenders for this project, and these were reviewed by staff. Tenders were as follows:

Analysis

The low bid submitted by Parkwood Construction was evaluated by the project team. The firm has had experience in many projects of similar type and size. The superintendent is ready and available for this project on a full-time basis. It is anticipated that the project will take 8 to 10 weeks following award of Contract. It is anticipated that the branch will be open to the public in late 2003.

The tender amounts and various separate prices were evaluated adjusting the proposed contract amount as shown in the table above.

The low bid received from Parkwood Construction in the amount of \$369,569 is within the total project funding available.

September 18, 2003

The balance of project funding available will accomplish the planned renovations to Brighouse Library in order to achieve the operating efficiencies which will offset the Cambie Branch Library operating costs.

Financial Impact

There is no financial impact as the tender results fall within the total project funding available.
