

STAFF REPORT

The election held on Saturday, October 13th, 2001, was the fourth using the automated counting system. Again, voter satisfaction of the system was very high, especially because accidentally overvoted ballots were returned to the voter for correction. All of the results were available at City Hall by approximately 8:40 p.m. on election night.

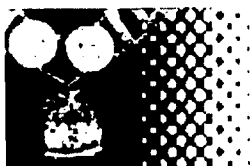
This year, the City web site was used as the primary means to report the results of the election. Because the data from the vote counting units was electronically compiled and uploaded directly to the web site, the results were made simultaneously available to the media and the community at large in the shortest possible time frame.

Attached are the overall election results, together with a "poll by poll" breakdown for each candidate for each office. A total of 23,727 people voted, which compares with 22,602 for the General Local Election in 1999, 20,730 in 1996 and 19,572 in 1993. The voter turnout for the by-election was 32%.
