



STAFF REPORT

For the last 15 years, the second regular Council meeting in December has been cancelled due to the holiday season. This year the second meeting in December will fall on Wednesday, December 29th, 2004, because the City Hall will be closed on Monday, December 27th, and Tuesday, December 28th, 2004, to observe Christmas Day and Boxing Day respectively.

Cancellation of the Christmas period Council meeting has had no impact on City operations in the past, and if Council agrees to continue the practice, a four-week interval would be created between the Council meeting of Monday, December 13th, 2004, and Monday, January 10th, 2005. At this time it is anticipated that the December Public Hearing (scheduled for Monday, December 20th, 2004) would be held as normal.
