Staff Report

Origin

A Local Area Services Program Petition (formally Local Improvement Program) was successfully circulated and certified on September 29, 2004 for Basic Ditch Elimination on 9951 Greenlees Road and 7540 Bates Road as shown on the attached sketch (attachment 2).

The Community Charter requires that Council adopt a report outlining the expected life of the local area services program and cost-sharing for it prior to adopting the Local Area Services Program Construction Bylaw for the work. This report satisfies those requirements of the Community Charter.

Analysis

In support of the Local Area Services Program Construction Bylaw and as required under Section 211 and 212 of the *Community Charter*, this report confirms that:

- 1. The estimated cost of the work is \$44,000.00;
- 2. The estimated share or proportion of the total cost which will be specially charged against the parcels benefiting from or abutting on the work is \$19,043.04 and the estimated share to be borne by the City is \$24,956.96. Final charges will be based on the actual cost;
- 3. The proportion of the total cost to be borne by the City is one third along the frontage (Bates Road) and three quarters along the flankage (Greenlees Road);
- 4. The charge per taxable front metre against the various parcels is estimated to be \$388.00;
- 5. The number of instalments by which the special charges shall be made payable are 15;

A \$2,000.00 credit has been obtained from CPS Enterprises Ltd, the developer of the property at 9971 Greenlees Road (SA 03-227575). The City and the developer opted to defer some of the work required in the Servicing Agreement as it would have been removed once this LASP project is constructed. The \$2000.00 credit will be distributed to the residents (\$865.59) and to the City (\$1134.41).

Financial Impact

In the 2004 budget an estimated amount of \$712,320.00 is remaining for the City's share of the Local Improvement Projects. The amount of \$24,956.96 would be funded from that source. The estimated balance left in this account after funding this project will be \$687,363.04.

Conclusion

We recommend that this project proceed because financing is in place and the benefiting residents have approved the work by petition in accordance with the *Community Charter*.



Local Area Services Program Construction Bylaw No. 7837

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

PART ONE: DESCRIPTION OF LOCAL AREA SERVICES PROGRAM

The following work is authorized to be undertaken as a local area service:

- Basic ditch elimination at: Property frontages of 9951 Greenlees Road and 7540 Bates Road
- 1.1 The estimated cost of such work is \$44,000.00.
- The share of the estimated cost of work to be borne by the parcels which benefit from or abut the work is \$19,043.04 and the share to be borne by the City is \$24,956.96.
- The estimated annual charge to be specially charged against **parcels** benefiting from or abutting the **work** is \$388.00 per metre of taxable frontage, payable in 15 annual instalments.
- Upon completion of the work, the actual cost of the work will be specially charged against the parcels benefiting from or abutting the work, provided that:
 - (a) the costs to be charged will not exceed the estimated amount set out in section 1.2 by more than 10%; and
 - (b) the City will pay any costs which exceed the estimated amount by more than 10%.

PART TWO: FRONTAGES

- 2.1 The total taxable frontages of the **parcels** benefiting from or abutting the work is 49.08 metres.
- 2.2 The taxable frontage, estimated annual charge, and commuted payment amount for each parcel benefiting from or abutting the work is:

PARCEL means a lot, block, or other area in which land

is held or into which land is legally

subdivided.

WORK means the local area services program

specified in section 1.1 and authorized under Sections 211 and 212 of the Community

Charter

PART FOUR: SEVERABILITY AND CITATION

4.1 If any part, section, subsection, clause, or sub clause of this bylaw is, for any reason, held to be invalid by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision does not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw.
