1. Section 7 of Schedule A to Bylaw No. 7321 is amended by adding "Licence Inspector" to the list of designated bylaw enforcement officers.
2. Schedule B7 to Bylaw No. 7321 is amended by adding the following:

Offence	Bylaw Section	Fine
Selling Roman candles other than as part of a family pack	3(c)	\$100

3. This Bylaw is cited as "Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw No. 7321, Amendment Bylaw No. 7586".

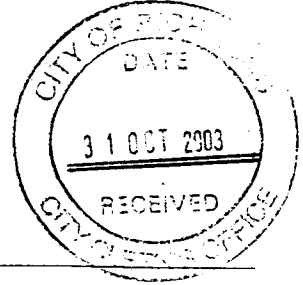


Re: Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Amendment Bylaw 7586
