### Staff Report

### Origin

Business Licence fees are established by Council in Business Licence Bylaw 7360. As per the Long Term Financial Management Strategy (LTFMS), and in keeping with Policy Nine of the (LTFMS), all user fees are to be increased annually by CPI.

### Analysis

For the licence year 2007, Council approved a fee increase of 2% which was based on the cost of living as of July 2006. For the licence year beginning January 1, 2008, and in keeping with the LTFMS, licence fees will be increased by 2%, rounded up to the nearest whole dollar. This figure is based on the CPI of 2.1%, obtained from Stats B.C. as of July 2007.

Also adopted by Council last year, was the introduction of an administrative fee for requests from businesses for additional copies of their issued business licences, as the original had either been lost, misfiled or kept by head office. Staff have also noted increased requests from the general public for copies of a company's business licence for potential court proceedings. Staff are finding that the nominal fee set last year does not accurately reflect the staff time, processing and mail costs and recommend that the fee be adjusted as set out in the attached schedule.

### Financial Impact

Based on the number of licences issued in 2007, and with the proposed increase of 2%, approximately \$52,000 in additional fees could be expected.

### Conclusion


The inflationary costs of administering the licence bylaw, an increase in enforcement costs, and the fact that fees have only been raised once since 2004, would indicate that the proposed increase is warranted.

- 1. Each Vehicle for Hire applicant must pay:
  - (a) an office licence fee of \$114; and
  - (b) the following per vehicle Licence Fee, based on number of vehicles:

CLASS "B" Limousine	\$70
CLASS "C" Sightseeing Taxicab	\$104
CLASS "D" Airport Taxicab	\$104
CLASS "E" Private Bus	\$104
CLASS "I" Charter Minibus	\$104
CLASS "J" Rental Vehicle	
Group 1	\$13
Group 2	\$70
CLASS "K" Driver Training Vehicle	\$51

- 2. Notwithstanding the per-vehicle licence fees stipulated in Section 1, the maximum licence fee for any Vehicle for Hire business is \$3,287.
- 3. The fee for transferring a Vehicle for Hire Licence within any calendar year is \$39
- 4. The fee for replacing a Vehicle for Hire Licence plate or decal is \$12

### SCHEDULE B to BYLAW NO. 7360

- 1. The fee for transferring a licence from one person to another, or for issuing a new licence because of a change in information on the face of such licence, except a change between licence categories or subcategories, is \$39.
- 2. The fee for changing the category or subcategory of a licence is either:
  - (a) \$39; or
  - (b) the difference between the existing licence fee and the fee for the proposed category or subcategory,

whichever is the greater.

3. The fee for a Business Licence reprint is \$10.00.
