Staff Report

Origin

This report follows the recommendations of the Steveston Advisory Task Force On Parking that City operated public parking spaces in the Steveston Village be managed though the use of time restrictions for short-term stay users.

Analysis

The two parking lots included in this proposal have been identified by the Steveston Task Force for short-term parking and signs have been erected indicating the lots have a maximum stay of 2 hours. The lots, however, have not previously been included in Schedule A of the Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw. Inclusion of the parking lots in Schedule A will allow enforcement of the time restrictions on parking in these locations.

Conclusion

The proposed amendments to the Traffic Bylaw and Parking (Off-Street) Bylaw will promote turnover of parking in the two lots and provide increased available parking close to the business centre for people visiting and shopping in the community.

- 1. Schedule A to Bylaw No. 7403 is amended by adding the following to the list of properties
 - 2.1 **12200 2nd Avenue,** Lot 12, Section 10, Block 3 North Range 7 West Plan 249 Suburban Block 5.
 - 2.2 **3771 Bayview Street,** Lot 14, Section 10, Block 3 North Range 7 West Plan 249 Suburban Block 5.
- 2. This Bylaw is cited as "Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw No. 7403, Amendment Bylaw No. 7631".
