



## **Staff Report**

### **Origin**

This report follows the recommendations of the Steveston Advisory Task Force On Parking that City operated public parking spaces in the Steveston Village be managed through the use of time restrictions for short-term stay users.

### **Analysis**

The two parking lots included in this proposal have been identified by the Steveston Task Force for short-term parking and signs have been erected indicating the lots have a maximum stay of 2 hours. The lots, however, have not previously been included in Schedule A of the Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw. Inclusion of the parking lots in Schedule A will allow enforcement of the time restrictions on parking in these locations.

### **Conclusion**

The proposed amendments to the Traffic Bylaw and Parking (Off-Street) Bylaw will promote turnover of parking in the two lots and provide increased available parking close to the business centre for people visiting and shopping in the community.

**Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw 7403  
Amendment Bylaw No. 7631**

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

1. Schedule A to Bylaw No. 7403 is amended by adding the following to the list of properties
  21. **12200 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**, PID 011-481-102 Lot 12, Block 5 Section 10 Block 3 North Range 7 West New Westminster District Plan 249.
  22. **3771 Bayview Street**, PID 003-644-120 Lot 14 Block 5 Section 10 Block 3 North Range 7 West New Westminster District Plan 249.
2. This Bylaw is cited as **“Parking (Off-Street) Regulation Bylaw No. 7403, Amendment Bylaw No. 7631”**.
