Staff Report

Origin

Bylaw No. 7299, an amendment to the Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw No. 7139, was prepared in conjunction with amendments to the Business Regulation Bylaw No. 7148. The amendments clarified the wording relating to closing hours for amusement centres. The amendments received first, second and third readings on November 13, 2001. However, technical difficulties were encountered in having the bylaw approved by the Chief Judge of the Province and consequently a revised amendment is being brought forward in the form of Bylaw No. 7311 (attached). Bylaw No. 7299 can be abandoned.

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

- Schedule B 3 is amended by deleting the offence of "Operating amusement machines outside the permitted hours" and substituting the following:

Offence	Bylaw Section	Fine
Operating an amusement centre outside the permitted hours	5.2.3	\$100
