

Richmond Tree Protection Bylaw 8057 Amendment Bylaw 8157

The Council of the City of Richmond, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1.	Part Two of Richmond Tree Protection	Bylaw	8057	is	amended	by	adding	the	following
	definition, in alphabetical order:					•			

"TOPPING

means the removal of major portions of a **tree** crown by **cutting** branches to stubs or to the trunk or **cutting** of the main leader or branches, and includes re-topping of previously topped **trees**."

2. Subsection 4.3.1 of Bylaw No. 8057 is amended by inserting the following sentence between the second and third paragraphs:

"If a tree or trees located on any parcel form part of a hedge, the Manager may require that less than one replacement tree be planted and maintained for each tree that is cut."

3. This bylaw is cited as "Richmond Tree Protection Bylaw 8057, Amendment Bylaw No. 8157".
