Staff Report

Origin

The following Bylaws were considered and adopted by Council:

- Animal Control Regulation Bylaw No. 7932 on June 13, 2005;
- Dog Licencing Bylaw No. 7138, Amendment Bylaw No. 7965 on July 11, 2005; and
- Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw No. 7321, Amendment Bylaw No. 7934 on June 27, 2005

Analysis

Since the adoption of the above named bylaws, a number of inconsistencies have been discovered in the way the Animal Control Regulation Bylaw and the Dog Licencing Bylaw section references and fine information are cited in the Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw. This was caused by an oversight during the bylaw drafting process. The affected portions of the bylaws were related primarily to Animal Control issues.

This has produced very viable Animal Control and Dog Licencing Bylaws but has left the Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw with inconsistent section number and fines for certain infractions. This has made it impossible to enforce under a number of sections of the Bylaws.

The attached amendment bylaw will correct the Schedules of the Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw and allow effective enforcement to continue.

Financial Impact

Given the housekeeping nature of these amendments, there is no change to applicable fees or fines and no financial impact from adoption. All financial implications were addressed and considered by Council during the original amendments in June, 2005.

Conclusion

Staff recommends adoption of the amended Schedule B1 for the Animal Control Bylaw, Schedule B3 for Business Regulation Bylaw and Schedule B5 for Dog Licencing Bylaw within the Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw.

CITY OF RICHMOND

MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION AUTHORIZATION BYLAW NO. 7321

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

PART ONE: GENERAL PROVISIONS

- **1.1** The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A may be enforced by means of a ticket, prescribed for that purpose, by regulation, under the *Local Government Act*.
- 1.2 The persons appointed to the positions listed in Column 2 of Schedule A are designated as **Bylaw Enforcement Officers** pursuant to the *Local Government Act*, for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A, opposite the respective positions.
- 1.3 The words or expressions shown in Column 1 of Schedule B 1 through B 15 inclusive, designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2, opposite the respective words or expressions.
- 1.4 The dollar amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules B 1 through B 15 inclusive, are the fines established pursuant to the *Local Government Act*, for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
- 1.5 Schedule A, together with Schedules B 1 through B 15 inclusive, are designated a part of this bylaw.

PART TWO: INTERPRETATION

2.1 In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER means:

(a) a Licence Inspector: or

(b) a person employed by the **Contractor** to undertake animal control services

undertake animal control services.

BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER means an employee of the City, appointed by

Council for the enforcement of City bylaws.

CITY means the City of Richmond.

means the person, firm or society with whom the **City** has entered into an agreement for (i) the operation of an animal shelter; (ii) the provision of animal control services; (iii) the provision and supplying of **Animal Control Officers**; (iv) the licencing of dogs; and (v) the issuing of tickets under the provisions of the Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw.

COUNCIL

means the Council of the City.

LICENCE INSPECTOR

means the person appointed by **Council** as Licence Inspector for the **City** and includes **Bylaw Enforcement Officers** and the Chief Licence Inspector.

MEDICAL HEALTH OFFICER

means the Medical Health Officer appointed under the *Health Act*, or his designate, to act within the limits of the jurisdiction of any local board, or within any health district.

POLICE OFFICER

means a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.

PART THREE: PREVIOUS BYLAW REPEAL

3.1 Municipal Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw No. 7139 (adopted on August 10th, 2000) and the following amendment bylaws are repealed:
