#### Staff Report

#### Origin

In April 2001 the City initiated a Business Licence Process Review project. The review focused on improving customer service, streamlining processes, increasing efficiencies through better use of technology, eliminating redundancies and improving response times. A review of the existing business licence fee schedules was a component of the project.

#### **Analysis**

Business licence fees are currently set by Council in the Business Licence Bylaw No. 6901 schedules "A" and "B". The last fee review and was conducted in 1997 and resulted in the following increases for the 1998 Licence year.

- a) The basic licence fee was increased from \$87.00 to \$100.00 (14.9%).
- b) All other business licence fees were increased by 1% rounded up to the next whole dollar.

There have been no fee increases in each of the past four years.

Since 1997 the business licence department has seen a variety of increases in the cost of issuing business licences and providing ongoing enforcement of the Business Licence and Business Regulation Bylaws. Some of the increased costs include:

- salaries and basic operating overhead expenses,
- . upgrades or replacements of outdated equipment,
- new partnerships with the Community Safety Division, in particular the RCMP, which have led to increased off-hours enforcement; and
- reduced or eliminated resources through senior levels of government including: the Provincial Health Unit, Liquor Control Branch and Motor Carrier Branch (now ICBC) which have led to increased responsibilities for municipal licencing departments.

In light of these increases City staff are recommending an increase of 3%, rounded up to the nearest whole dollar, to all business licences effective January 1, 2002.

#### **Financial Impact**


The City will realize increased revenues of approximately \$66,000 for the licence year of 2002.

#### Conclusion

The proposed amendment to the Business Licence Bylaw No. 6901 and the resulting business licence fee increase will more accurately reflect the costs associated with the service provided while minimizing the impact on local businesses.

- 1. Each Vehicle for Hire applicant must pay:
  - (a) an office licence fee of \$103; and
  - (b) the following per vehicle Licence Fee, based on number of vehicles;

CLASS >B= Limousine	\$63
CLASS >C= Sightseeing Taxicab	\$94
CLASS >D= Airport Taxicab	\$94
CLASS >E= Private Bus	\$94
CLASS >I= Charter Minibus	\$94
CLASS >J= Rental Vehicle	-
Group 1	\$11
Group 2	\$63
CLASS >K= Driver Training Vehicle	\$47

- 2. Nothwithstanding the per-vehicle licence fees stipulated in Section 1, the maximum licence fee for any Vehicle for Hire business is \$3,000.
- 3. The fee for transferring a Vehicle for Hire Licence within any calendar year is \$35.
- 4. The fee for replacing a Vehicle for Hire Licence plate or decal is \$10.
