2. AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE GREEN MUNICIPAL INVESTMENT FUND AGREEMENTS

3. PROPOSED ANNUAL INFLATIONARY INCREASE IN FEES COLLECTED BY TRANSPORTATION AND ENGINEERING DEPARTMENTS

(Report: Nov. 8/05, File No.: 12-8060-20-7994; xr 0970-03-01) (REDMS No. 1680909)

It was moved and seconded

- (1) That the following fees collected by the City's Transportation Department be increased annually by an amount equal to the previous year's Consumer Price Index for Greater Vancouver, effective January 2006:
 - (a) location rental fees for the placement of bus stop benches on City property; and
 - (b) traffic signal and administration fees for the management, on behalf of the Vancouver International Airport Authority, of selected traffic signals, count stations and flashers located on Sea Island.
- (2) That Bylaw No. 7994, which amends Traffic Control and Regulation Bylaw No. 5870 to establish an annual increase effective January 2006 equal to the previous year's Consumer Price Index for Greater Vancouver in the fees collected by the City for the approval and issuance of:
 - (a) (i) Oversize/Overweight Vehicle Trip Permits;
 - (b) (ii) Building Move Permits; and
 - (c) (iii) Construction Loading Zone Permits,

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be introduced and given first, second and third reading.

- (3) That the following fees collected by the City's Engineering Department be increased annually by an amount equal to the previous year's Consumer Price Index for Greater Vancouver, effective January 2006:
 - (a) sales of section maps, street maps and as-built drawings; and
 - (b) sales of drafting specifications and standards manuals.

The Acting Manager, Transportation Planning, Donna Chan, briefly reviewed with the Committee, three memos sent to all members of Council, in response to referrals to Transportation staff on:

- (1) a Vancouver Sun Newspaper Article "Traffic Snarl" (June 20th, 2005);
- (2) the designation of Blundell Road as an arterial road; and
- (3) the Iona Island Ferry Terminal Concept Summary of Past Studies.

Councillor Barnes referred to the November 23rd, 2005 edition of *The Province*, which highlighted the efforts of Dylan Green of Tofino who launched a public transit system with buses which operate on a vegetable oil-based bio-fuel, and she asked staff to review this concept.
