



**City Of Richmond Solid Waste & Recycling Regulation Bylaw 6803  
Amendment Bylaw 7300 (2002)**

The Council of the City of Richmond, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The City of Richmond Solid Waste and Recycling Regulation Bylaw 6803 is hereby amended by deleting Schedule A, Schedule B, Schedule C and Schedule D, and by substituting Schedule A, Schedule B, Schedule C and Schedule D attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
2. This Bylaw may be cited as "**Solid Waste and Recycling Regulation Bylaw 6803, Amendment Bylaw 7300 (2002)**".
