Animal Control Regulation Bylaw No. 7932, Amendment Bylaw No. 8598

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

- 1. Animal Control Regulation Bylaw No. 7932, as amended, is further amended by deleting subsection 2.3.5.2 in its entirety and substituting the following:
 - 2.3.5.2 As exceptions to subsection 2.3.5.1:
 - (a) No owner may have more than three (3) dogs off-leash at any one time, except an owner who is a professional dog walker with a valid off-leash permit may have up to six (6) dogs off-leash in the designated dog off-leash area within McDonald Park; and
 - (b) No owner may permit a dangerous dog to be off-leash in a designated dog off-leash area.
- 2. Animal Control Regulation Bylaw No. 7932, as amended, is further amended at section 9.1 by adding the following definitions in alphabetical order:

OFF-LEASH PERMIT

means a permit issued to a professional dog walker pursuant to subsection 2.3.2 of the Business Licence Bylaw No. 7360, as amended or replaced from time to time

3. This Bylaw is cited as "Animal Control Regulation Bylaw No. 7932, Amendment Bylaw No. 8598".
