

Air Quality Modelling Analysis of Options for Management of Waste After Recycling

Received

Roger Quan, Division Manager, Air Quality Planning, Metro Vancouver, made an oral report and PowerPoint about the air quality implications of different waste disposal options. Under all eight scenarios, consultant RWDI AIR Inc. concluded that emissions from solid waste management will not appreciably change by 2020 and will represent between 0.1 per cent and 1.2 per cent of total air contaminants in the region.

Next Steps and Content to be used in Development of the Solid Waste Management Plan

Deferred

During an oral report, Chief Administrative Officer Johnny Carline Metro Vancouver noted staff had not made any recommendations about a preferred option for the disposal of solid waste management. The CAO said staff would study the reports during the summer and make recommendations to the Waste Management Committee in September on a draft solid waste management plan that would be reviewed during a public consultation process in the fall. The board deferred for two weeks a motion that the reports be received for use in the development of the draft solid waste management plan. The same reports, as well as other presentations waste disposal options, will be made at a Council of Councils meeting on Saturday, June 27. All elected members of councils in Metro Vancouver and the Fraser Valley Regional District are being invited to the Council of Councils. The meeting will be held from 9 a.m. to noon, on Saturday, June 27, at the Executive Plaza Hotel, 405 North Road, in Coquitlam.
