Dedication by Bylaw 8446 and Repeal of Bylaw 8248

Staff Recommendation

That:

- 1. Road Closure and Removal of Road Dedication Bylaw 8446 be introduced and given 1st, 2nd and 3rd readings;
- 2. The required notice of road closure and disposition of the closed road be advertised prior to final adoption pursuant to the Community Charter;
- 3. Staff be authorized to take all necessary steps to raise title to the road closure area and transfer the road closure area on the same terms and conditions as outlined in the Council report dated September 26, 2007 and approved November 13, 2007, including authorizing the Manager, Real Estate Services, to execute all documentation to effect the transactions, including all contracts, survey plans and Land Title Office documentation; and
- 4. Staff be authorized to file a certifying statement executed by the Corporate Officer in the Land Title Office cancelling the right of resumption pursuant to the Resumption of Highways Regulation.

Staff Report

Origin

The matter of Bylaw 8248 (Attachment 1) first appeared before Council on November 13, 2007, where it received 1st, 2nd and 3rd readings in conjunction with rezoning application RZ 06-348261 It was duly advertised on January 3 and 10, 2008 with final adoption occurring on January 14, 2008. It has since been noted that there was an error in the title of the plan attached to Bylaw 8248 as Schedule A. It stated, incorrectly, that the road portion that was being closed was road dedicated by the deposit of Plan 15456. In fact, the correct plan number was 18549. The report also incorrectly referred to Plan 15456 instead of to 18549.

Accordingly, Bylaw 8248 is defective; it needs to be repealed and a new bylaw adopted in its place. Bylaw 8446 is the replacement bylaw and is being presented for consideration and forwarding to Council for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd readings.

Analysis.

In order to complete the road closure, Council is required to adopt a Road Closure and Removal of Road Dedication Bylaw. Accordingly, Bylaw 8446, which contains the necessary authority to close the Road and remove the road dedication, is presented for consideration and forwarding to open Council for 1st, 2nd and 3rd readings (Attachment 2). This matter will be advertised after which it will held for final adoption.

The previous report to Council on this matter (dated September 26, 2007) detailed the calculation of the applicable market value consideration for the sale of the road closure area. As summarized in that report, the estimated market value of the Road was \$158,638. However, due to the extraordinary cost to the Developer for local upgrades (estimated at \$400,000) the parties agreed in 2006 to a purchase price of \$146,000, which Council approved at its meeting on November 13, 2007.

Financial Impact

Upon adoption of Bylaw 8446, staff will complete the transactions outlined in the September 26, 2007 report with the proceeds of the sale (\$146,000 less appraisal cost of \$3,250) being credited to the Capital Reserve Fund - Industrial Use.

Conclusion

Due to the defective nature of Bylaw 8248, it needs to be repealed, which will occur upon adoption of Bylaw 8446.

Council approval and adoption of the Road Closure and Removal of Road Dedication Bylaw 8446 is required to raise title to the road closure area. Upon adoption of Bylaw 8446, staff will complete the transactions outlined in the September 26, 2007 report.

Road Closure and Removal of Road Dedication for Portion of Albion Road – Bylaw 8248

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

- 1. The lands described as Parcel A on the Reference Plan prepared by Louis Ngan Land Surveying Inc., B.C.L.S. attached as Schedule A shall be stopped up and closed to traffic, cease to be a public road and the road dedication shall be removed.
- 2. Parcel A shall be disposed of to the owners of 10020 Albion Road for consolidation with their adjoining development lands at 10020 Albion Road, Richmond.
- 3. This Bylaw is cited as "Road Closure and Removal of Road Dedication Bylaw Number 8248".

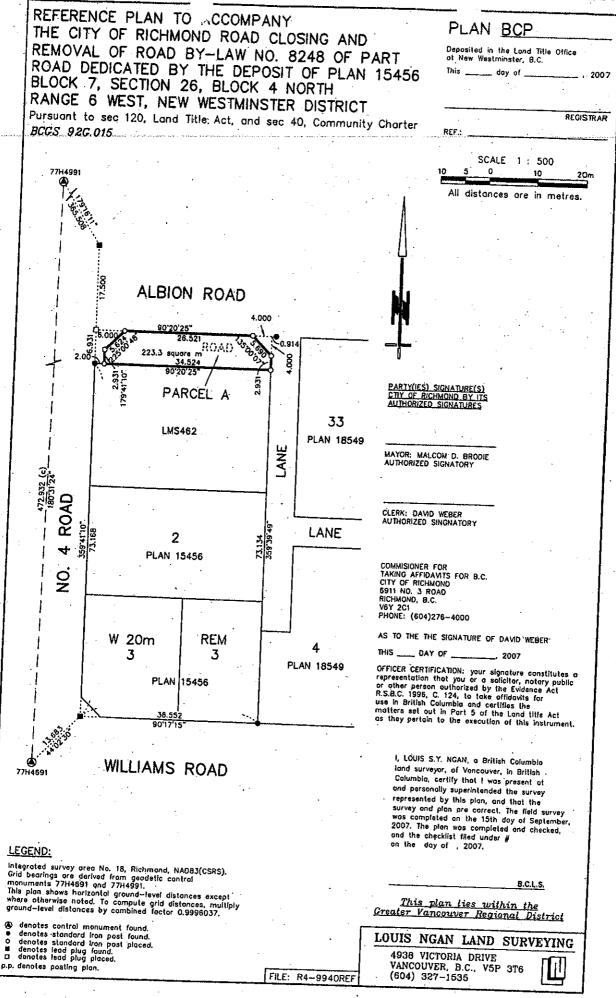

The Council of the City of Richmond enacts as follows:

- 1. The lands legally described as Part Road Dedicated by the Deposit of Plan 18549 Block 7 Section 26 Block 4 North Range 6 West New Westminster District (shown as Parcel A on the Reference Plan prepared by Louis Ngan Land Surveying, B.C.L.S. attached as Schedule A) shall be stopped up and closed to traffic, cease to be a public road and the road dedication shall be removed.
- 2. Road Closure and Removal of Road Dedication Bylaw Number 8248 is repealed.
