Richmond Elementary School Program – Climate Change Showdown Champion Presentation

The City of Richmond, in partnership with the BC Sustainable Energy Association and Richmond School District, has engaged elementary school children throughout Richmond in the Climate Change Showdown Challenge. The students' involvement in this interactive program helps the Richmond community take positive action to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, address climate change and support the advancement of community sustainability.

The 2011 Climate Change Showdown Challenge marks a very successful year in Richmond. With over 1100 students participating, community action across Richmond resulted in a reduction of over 700 tonnes of greenhouse gas emissions. This presentation recognizes one of the class champions of the 2010 challenge who had the highest per student reduction.
