Please find attached a letter from the Canadian Federation of Humane Societies, a national organization which represents SPCAs and other humane organizations across Canada. After meeting with PIJAC representatives at the pet industry's Animal Strategies Meeting in Banff last month, they issued this formal response with respect to Richmond Council's proposed ban on the sale of dogs in pet stores and PIJAC's discussions on a national code of conduct.

I also wanted to let you know that several other municipalities have contacted us, expressing support and interest in Richmond Council's proposed ban and asking for background information for their own regions.

As well, Richmond Council is cited by Langley Township Councillor Jordan Bateman in an article that will appear in the Province newspaper this Sunday in the pet section. As you will be aware, Langley Township councillors recently voted unanimously on a motion directing staff to draft a bylaw regarding the sale of dogs and to bring back the proposed bylaw within eight weeks. In the upcoming Province story Councillor Bateman applauds Richmond Council's leadership and says it has made it "100 times easier for us to do something in our own community".

Dear Mayor & Councillors, Bylaw Managers, Manager Municipal Animal Shelters (Pounds) & Media

The ongoing, largely unabated dilemma experienced across North America can be resolved where the "Political will" exists to do so. Many progressive Municipalities have adopted partial bylaw solutions, by adopting partial Bylaws to govern certain aspects of Animal Welfare/Control but sadly, most stop short of adopting comprehensive long-term solutions for some unknown reason.

We have taken the initiative and now take the liberty to provide you with solutions that have been on our web.site since approximately 1995 or thereabouts. You can read the attached copy or conversely, view our web.site at www.thecouncilclaw.ca 'click' OUR POSITION ON ISSUES and 'scroll' down to reach SECTION 31 ANIMAL RELATION PROGRAM.

In either event the solutions are there to those who wish to resolve the issue, the important thing is to read, understand, act and this can be gradual, using the complete Section 31 (incorporate additional component 'click' Fines & Penalty for recommended fine amounts, etc.) as a 'checklist' to follow. Thus, developing your own legal jargon, that your Bylaw people are more well versed at composing, as we merely, in most cases, outline concept and important components, not necessarily the legalese.

The other important point to realize, it must be a 'regional' approach, such as Greater Vancouver Regional District or Fraser Valley Regional District, several adjacent Municipalities or ideally Province wide, as the problem and its cause is Province wide, thus, the broader & greater attack to remedy, the more likelihood of success. Further, you must have the conviction to do what is needed & right, not be swayed by self-interest groups, such as PIJAC (representing some Retail Stores) or "Professional Dog Breeder Organizations" who include breeders & show dog clientele (most "Professional Breeders" can be excluded from the Bylaws proposed).

The point may be self-explanatory but for example, the City of Richmond recently adopted a "No sale of pets in Pet Stores" which is admirable, in part, to fight puppy (kitten) mills (if only in Richmond, B.C.). Thus, if Richmond stops selling pets in pet stores, the indiscriminate breeder just moves to Delta, or Surrey, etc. But it is an international problem or at least locally, regional in nature. Thus, to have greater impact and effect, all (adjacent) Municipalities need to adopt such a provision, which in itself is but a small part of the overall Animal Relations (let me hasten to add, Richmond has, like some other Municipalities adopted other bylaw components, like spay & neuter, but in each case, just not broad enough to have greatest effect, per the objective our (program), as reading, will attest for you.

It follows, for example, if a retail ban is in effect good but to combat more effectively the "puppy & kitten mill" dilemma, a "Breeder Permit" scheme is needed (breeding for personal use, Breeding for sale), thus, those permitted to breed Animals (dogs or cats) will obtain a "permit" and thus, a "registration number" and then this "number" must appear on all records, advertising of any nature, bill of sale, etc. The "Breeder Permit" when combined with the "Basic Animal Care & Control" bylaw, will set forth acceptable standards of breeding & care, Hence, the puppy & kitten mill can become an injustice & cruelty to Animals, of the past. Facilities of all "Registered Breeders" can be inspected and any un-registered Breeder heavily fined, rendering, for example, a puppy mill as unprofitable.

Another important point to understand is, "fines must be a minimum twice as much as complying", as each is added as a "cost of doing business" (same rationale applies to any infraction, fines must make it unprofitable & unpopular) to have success to create the deterrent factor or subsequent penalty factor. For example, a spay operation of \$ 50.00 must have at least a \$ 100.00 fine for non-compliance.

To my thinking it is a "no brainer" that if elected politicians wish to represent constituents and make their Municipality safe from roaming/vicious dog attacks, animals not breeding prolifically causing mass overpopulation, strays & feral cats all over, then action must be swift and conclusive.

We have witnessed the 'blip' in media coverage when a vicious attack upon a child, causing severe injury, recently the Horse being attacked, earlier pet Dogs killed or Cat maimed and on and on, just a matter of "when" not "if" as it will happen. But my point, it is clear most (politicians) have elected to "ride out the bad media for a few weeks (unfortunately short attention span prevails)", then it is back to normal, until next time, hopefully in another Municipality. The lack of compassion, indeed perceived indifference is overwhelming and I must profess I do not understand why or why most politicians are perceived negligent, and do not seem to care or take prudent measures to (prevent) harm. For years thousands of Cats were unceremoniously killed as a population measure, an out of sight out of mind, until massive public pressure, notably upon BCSPCA caused measures to change.

So, I will not belabour the matter further, at this time, except to strongly encourage all to read, understand and agree to act along the lines prescribed in our Animal Relations Program. The solutions are mostly evident, quite easy to adopt if the compassion & political will exists but please, consider doing as a major region with your neighbour Municipalites. While at it, look at our "Gallery of Horrors" to gain some additional insight to animal cruelty that prevails and will continue, possibly in your Municipality, until you take progressive steps to remedy. In closing, whether "dangerous or vicious dogs, to unsafe roaming dogs, to prolific cat breeding & steady stream of strays at your door" they will persist (in varying degree of severity or frequency) until you act to protect Animals and responsible Guardians.

Dear Richmond City Council,

May I start off by congratulating the work of council in this matter so far. What you have done marks a landmark in taking action against animal cruelty and unethical business. You truly have set a precedent for others to follow.

I am very active in the dog community; through rescue, BC Guide Dogs, Canine Search and Rescue and the local Golden Retriever community, and thus have significant experience both with shelters and with dogs bred by reputable breeders. Via myself, several online communities, particularly the Golden Retriever Online Forum, have been following your progress and as result 25 different municipalities across the US, England and Kuwait have initiated a ban on pet store puppy sales as a result of your action.

I have fostered dogs, including ones that have come from puppy mills, backyard breeders and pet stores. I have also been involved in training Seeing-Eye Dogs and I am the proud owner of a purebred Golden Retriever who I am currently training for both Dog Therapy (West Coast Assistance Teams) and Search and Rescue (Surrey Search and Rescue). His registered name with the Canadian Kennel Club is Redgold Prince of Persia ("Cosmo"). His pedigree and other information (including health clearance) on dogs in his line can be seen at K9Data. (http://www.k9data.com/pedigree.asp?ID=254272 and http://www.k9data.com/pedigree.asp?ID=216072). You are welcome to contact Redgold (www.redgold.org), our breeder, at any time to ask about Cosmo and all the dogs in his line, and to visit her breeding dogs. Her dogs are kept inside her home, while others are co-owned with families around BC. Absolutely none live in kennels and all are active in various venues, including show, work or other competition. A copy of our contract and CKC registration is readily available should you wish to view it.

Since at the previous council meetings on this matter no reputable breeders were present I would like to give you some important information of what the dog community considers a "reputable" breeder. I hope this information will provide the necessary information to show that no reputable breeder would under any circumstance sell a puppy or adult dog to a pet store. Thus the claim that pet stores use reputable breeders must be false. Similarly, the idea that in the future the city could enforce the use of reputable breeders for pet store is negated by default since there are no reputable breedersthat can or would provide dogs to pet stores.

- Reputable breeders only breed purebred and Canadian Kennel Club registered dogs. These
 breeders must be part of the CKC in good standing. The CKC by-laws
 (http://www.ckc.ca/en/Default.aspx?tabid=101) forbid breeders to sell dogs to pet stores (section
 III.G). Reputable breeders adhere to the CKC by-laws and will go significantly beyond these by-laws to ensure that they are meeting more than minimum standards in dog breeding. Breeders
 meeting only the CKC by-laws are not considered reputable by the dog community.
- Reputable breeders regularly test their breeding dogs for health issues common in each breed and make that information available to the general public. Those that do not pass cannot be used for breeding (section III.E).
- Reputable breeders are experts on the breed they work with, and they only produce litters in order to make their breed better healthier, stronger, longer living, smarter and more in keeping with the breed standard. They do not breed first and foremost to produce puppies for sale. They select dogs for breeding who have excelled in various different fields. For example, a Golden Retriever chosen for breeding may be expected to not only be healthy and have a good temperament, but to have performed exceptionally in the field, in search in rescue, in obedience trials or other competition or work venues.
- Reputable breeders are active members in their local breed club and dog competitions. They often are part of breed rescue and have a good reputation, and thus are part of the breeder referral programs that clubs run.
- Reputable breeders carefully breed dogs to bring in new genes and may import a stud dog from across the country or even world to achieve this.
- Reputable breeders only breed a few times a year and do not generally have more than one litter at a time. Their puppies are all spoken for before the puppies are born or sometimes even before a breeding occurs. Sales are achieved because of the breeder's good reputation and referrals from breed clubs, not advertising.
- Reputable breeders take specific steps to socialize their puppies from the day they are born, exposing them to different sounds, smells, sights and textures. They send their puppies home not before 7 weeks of age.
- Reputable breeders understand and educate their puppies' new owners about the importance of
 early socialization once in the home, noting that puppies must be socialized with everything
 around them (walking on a leash, being on a busy street, meeting other pets, etc.) before
 approximately 14 weeks of age in order to develop normally. They highlight that a dog kept
 inside or in a cage all day when it is young can not develop normally.
- Reputable breeders do not make profit. The cost of taking care of their dogs, breeding reputably, taking their dogs across the world for show, work and competition, usually far outweighs the money made on the sale of a litter.
- Reputable breeders select the homes of their carefully bred puppies with utmost care and scrutiny. They may turn down many applications and only select homes that are knowledgeable about dogs, and often the specific breed, and look for homes that have an interest in participating in competition and work venues with their new puppy as well.
- Reputable breeders do not allow people to simply select their own puppy from a litter but rather choose the appropriate puppy in a litter for the home based on various tests. The idea of selling their precious litter to a pet store which does not have breed expertise and cannot guarantee that each individual puppy go to a home that matches the puppy's temperament would be unheard of.
- Reputable breeders stay in constant contact with the new puppy owners and will take the dog back if the owners should not or do not want to keep it, either to re-home or to help train. Contract forbids the new owners to get rid of the dog to a shelter or other home.
- Reputable breeders have a life-long contract between them and the new puppy owners that must be upheld (see for example http://www.rebelcreek.com/agreement.html)

I myself or any number of reputable breeders would be more than happy to consult on this matter further with council if necessary.

Canada's First Ban on Puppies in Pet Stores

HSI Canada applauds Richmond (a Vancouver suburb) City Council for drafting a bylaw amendment that will ban the sale of puppies in commercial pet stores. The amendment, originally proposed by Councilor Ken Johnson, is the first of its kind in Canada, and will give pet store owners until April of 2011 to phase out the sale of puppies in their stores.

Investigations have shown time and again that the vast majority of puppies sold in pet stores come from puppy mills, cruel mass-production facilities where the breeding dogs are often confined to small wire cages for life and often deprived of the basics of humane care, solely to produce puppies for the pet trade. HSI Canada hopes that Richmond's actions will inspire other councils across Canada to take similar actions to combat the cruel conditions in which dogs are factory-farmed for profit, and congratulates Richmond for having the courage to be the first city in Canada to take this important step towards reducing the demand for puppy mill puppies.

Stopping puppy mills

Humane Society International/Canada fully supports banning the sale of puppies in pet stores, and, as part of our campaign against puppy mills, encourages pet stores across Canada to sign our <u>Puppy-Friendly Pet Store Pledge</u> [PDF]. Close to 50 pet stores across Canada have signed on to our pledge in the past two years, thus making it more difficult for puppy mill owners to find distributors for their puppies, and encouraging owners to adopt dogs from shelters.

Shelters throughout Canada needlessly euthanize countless dogs every year as a result the soaring pet population and the difficulty of re-homing adult and pre-owned dogs. By banning the sale of puppies in pet stores, the city of Richmond has taken Canada one step closer to shutting down inhumane puppy mills forever, and to being able to guarantee all dogs the proper care and love that they deserve.

We hope that councils across Canada will do likewise and ban the commercial sale of puppies through pet stores. While there will always be demand for puppies, we highly encourage people to adopt from their local shelter or purchase only from small, reputable breeders they have met and screened in person, instead of putting themselves at risk by buying from a potential puppy mill, either directly or indirectly.

Take action

Humane Society International/Canada encourages all dog lovers to write to their local councilor and suggest a similar ban. We also encourage you to write Richmond newspapers (Richmond Review, Richmond News, Vancouver Sun, and the Vancouver Province) to voice your support.

With this first step taken, we hope that councils across Canada will follow the example of Richmond, as well as several <u>U.S. cities</u>, which already have such bans in place, and ban the sale of puppies in pet stores. Albuquerque, New Mexico, for example, banned the commercial sale of companion animals in 2006. The city's veterinarians say that the situation for these animals has markedly improved since then, reporting a 35 percent drop in the euthanasia of animals in shelters, and a 23 percent rise in animal adoption.







I was looking over the minutes of the Oct. 12th Council meeting, and saw mention of the website Kijiji that Tim Hansen, Assistant Store Manager, PJs Pets spoke of as a source of puppy-mill dogs if people can't get them from a pet store. I searched for all dogs in the Vancouver listings, and there were a lot -- around 1000 for people selling in out to Maple Ridge and beyond. However, when I narrowed the search to just Richmond, I found just four ads. Two of the Kijiji ads were for dogs at the Pets Wonderful store and one was for a dog purchased at Pet Habitat in Richmond Centre that someone was trying to get rid of. The forth dog is just a single puppy being re-homed. It doesn't appear that Richmond puppy mills are using Kijiji to advertise their dogs. However, pet stores are.

Thank you, once again, for making such a well considered and thoroughly researched decision to ban the sale of dogs in pet stores. Last week, the Richmond News took a bold position with the editorial "City takes a bit out of suffering" supporting your decision and their view seems to be the prevailing one in Richmond. However, the Richmond Review editor was unsure as to where his paper stood and posed the issue (and the often-cried protest of the pet industry), of animal welfare being a provincial issue. I would like to share with you my response to their editorial.

Dear Editor of the Richmond Review:

I am grateful for your editorial (Animal Welfare a provincial issue). Your position on whether the issue of banning vs. regulating animal sales by the city, is a valid concern, but it appears to be based on several pieces of wrong information.

First, you state that the ban "won't do anything to improve animal welfare in Richmond" and "purchases that end badly for the pet—represents a tiny fraction of puppies being raised in the city". This is incorrect. In fact, based on the number of dogs surrendered and abandoned at the Richmond animal shelter, 57% are purebred dogs and roughly 1/2 of those came into the Richmond Animal Shelter with either admission by the owner that the dog was purchased at the Richmond pet store or an actual receipt from the pet store. This 'tiny fraction' you mention, represents around 90-100 dogs per year in Richmond. So, actually, stopping the sale of animals in pet stores will make a difference, at least in the number of animals who end up at the Richmond Animal Shelter and the suffering they endure beforehand.

Second, you state that "this shouldn't be city business. The provincial government level—and the B.C. SPCA, which handles animal welfare issues for the province—is where these issues should be dealt with." Actually, this issue is very much 'city business' because it is the city that doles out the money to pay for our animal shelter to be filled with dogs from pet stores, and it's the city that controls and regulates the pet stores via the Business licensing bylaws. In fact, this is very much in the jurisdiction of the city, and since the pet stores continue to deny that they are purchasing from puppy mills, despite all evidence to the contrary by both CBC Marketplace and the BC SPCA, the city did what they could to regulate the pet stores and protect it's animal shelter from abuse by industry animal dumping — a shelter that is not run by the SPCA, but by RAPS. And even for those cities that have shelters operated by the SPCA, it was the BC SPCA that recommended that Richmond ban the sale of dogs by amending Richmond's business licensing bylaw.

Furthermore, despite the fact that it seems to be the popular statement in the last week to say "it's the Province's job to regulate dog breeding and sales", I have yet to see even one response from the Province or any indication they are going to do anything about this issue. And why would they? It's the city governments that suffer the costs and see the cruelty involved when animals are sold in their cities,

and the Province can't regulate what dogs breeders are doing in the States. So unless the Province is prepared to amend the business licensing bylaws for all BC municipalities to ban the sale of dogs in pet stores — which I certainly hope they do — , the City Council was right to spend their time on this difficult and heartbreaking issue.

Ladies and Gentlemen, Hurrah, Hurray, Congratulations, Well Done, Take a Bow!

You have done the right thing in unanimously voting to draft the by-law halting the sale of puppies in pet stores. I am a Cairn Terrier owner who stumbled into the fact that there is such a thing as Cairn Terrier Rescue, 5 years ago. Since then I have become a foster home for Cairn Terriers, and am the foster home mentor for Canadian foster homes. In that role I have fostered several Cairns and supported other foster homes rehabilitating fostered Cairns, most of whom were breeding stock from puppy mills, no longer needed or no longer producing profitably. Our organization (www.cairnrescue.com) has taken in and adopted out over 2500 Cairns since its inception 10 years ago...mostly puppy mill dogs.

Most of the dogs arrive in ill health, with everything from a few to all teeth needing to be extracted, every kind of worm known to veterinary science, missing parts (ears, toes, eyes, eyes, legs, tails), home done C sections, hernias, bladder stones, urinary infections, respiratory infections, systemic infections, cysts, heart problems, chronic dry eye, infected ears, horrible skin conditions, damaged trachea from being debarked by a pipe down the throat, muscular-skeletal problems from no exercise and living in cramped crates, toe nails so long they have to be trimmed under anaesthesia....

Then there are the emotional problems....many of the dogs have never been touched kindly, nor hand fed and shy away from even a piece of cheese, shrink to the floor if touched, or are so shocked at being treated with love that they then shriek hysterically if left alone again. Many have no depth perception or any sense of how to navigate stairs (from having spent their lives in small crates). It is a testament to the resiliency of the breed that they learn to trust humans and become part of a family. Some fears take longer to overcome....men in hats, or leather jackets, or someone smoking. Some take weeks or months to find the courage to leave the safety of their kennel other than to eat or void.

Customers and even pet store owners such as Mr. Ang have no idea or compassion for the parents of the cute puppies behind the glass window, who spend their lives living in hell, pumping out puppies till they are no longer profitable. The lucky ones get turned over to rescue groups, or sold for next to nothing at huge dog auctions to other breeders or someone working under cover for a rescue group. The less lucky ones are euthanized by bullets or car exhaust.

You have made the right decision on taking the first small step in ending the sale of puppies and perhaps all mammals in pet stores in your city. Hopefully other cities/towns will follow your lead. You can't close down all puppy mills with this by-law, but your are doing something significant that will lead to further public education. The media attention that has come from this is invaluable for raising public awareness. Maybe fewer people will decide to buy a puppy online from a puppy mill broker in

the future. Maybe someone will try and convince the local newspaper to try and screen the kinds of people who advertise puppies for sale and refuse to publish ads from obvious brokers.

On behalf of all the puppymill dogs I have met, and all those still living in hell, I thank you from the bottom of my heart. If I can do anything at all to help ensure this by-law passes, please let me know.

Re: The ban on the sale of puppies in pet stores in Richmond, BC

Dear Mayor Brodie and Richmond City Council,

I am writing this letter to express my concern for your proposed ban in the sales of puppies from pet stores in the city of Richmond. There are several reasons why this ruling will be very infective and in some ways harmful.

Firstly, unless there is a province wide consensus on the ban of puppy sales, this ban will only harm Richmond businesses while providing minimal benefits to the welfare of puppies. The ban of puppy sales in Richmond will not stop citizens from purchasing their pets from other municipalities. For instance, a simple 30 minute commute will take customers to neighboring municipalities where puppies are still readily available.

Furthermore, if puppies are not available in Richmond stores and citizens refuse to commute to other municipalities, resourceful customers will purchase from vendors who post puppies for sale on private community postings. This is an extremely harmful practice, as regulatory bodies such as the SPCA cannot monitor such vendors as effectively as pet stores located in central locations. On a related note, banning the sales of puppies from stores will provide incentive for such online vendors to sell puppies from unregulated and unregistered premises, such as their basements or puppy mills.

Ms. Bryson, Director of BC SPCA, had provided promising statistics regarding a similar ban in Albuquerque, New Mexico which had been in place for the past four years. She advised council that this ban has resulted in animal adoptions increasing by 23% and animal euthanasia decreasing by 35% at Albuquerque city shelters since the ban¹. However, it must be noted that this number is NOT representative of puppies saved through the ban, and those impressive statistics are not likely to be seen in Richmond.

The Albuquerque ban includes all "companion animals" which includes both cats and dogs. Cats, generally having litters more readily, are likely to have skewed the apparent benefits of their ban. According to the ASPCA², among the cats and dogs in shelter there are approximately 10% more cats euthanized than dogs. The ASPCA also reports that there are nearly 10,000,000 more cats

owned than there are dogs owned by the public, providing more evidence that the benefits seen in Albuquerque may be from lower cat sales. Finally, the argument that Richmond will not benefit as much as Albuquerque in terms of a puppy ban stems from the lower population density seen in Metro Albuquerque compared to Metro Vancouver $(1,126.9/\text{km}^2 \text{ vs. } 5,335/\text{km}^2)^3$. The lower population density and the fewer number of pet shops in Albuquerque is likely to result in Albuquerque residents having a more difficult time finding dogs and cats from surrounding areas and online sources, compared to a resident of Richmond who can easily shop at a surrounding municipality.

Ms. Carol Reichert, Richmond Animal Protection Society expressed her concern that "the pet store industry is costing the City thousands of dollars and that approximately 30% of the work done by the shelter is related to animals from pet stores." Does this 30% also include other animals, such as cats, ferrets, etc.? However, how much work was saved by pet stores who provided caring dog owners with wise advice?

RAPS also presented City council with copies of the "Dog Owner Surrender Application" forms. Nevertheless, it must be noted that the copied documents were biased selections that do not represent all the forms present in their records. Furthermore, the questionnaires present on the RAPS "Dog Owners Surrender Application" must be validated to rule out if questions are presented in a manner that falsely persuades a dog owner to report the dog as being store bought. Someone who bought a dog from a breeder or a puppy mill is less likely to disclose this information due to inconvenience or embarrassment. It is always easy to write "Pet Shop" or "Pet Habitat" rather than being asked about the breeder name, location, and blood line. Finally, Ms. Reichert predicts that "... a ban in storefronts would put puppies out of the sight and minds of people who might otherwise purchase on impulse and emotion." The puppies available from pet shops are generally over \$1,500; therefore, I have a hard time believing that many people will have an "impulsive and emotional" purchase of \$2,000.

In conclusion, Richmond City Council can ban puppy sales, but this will not prevent a customer from shopping in other municipalities and online sources. Secondly, this ban will also create more unregistered sales via the internet and mills which cannot be monitored by the SPCA and government revenue agencies. Finally, pet store owners and employees are educated in the care of puppies which benefits countless number of pet owners; however, with a ban, pet stores will no longer be centers for education regarding the care of puppies.

Thank you very much for taking the time to read my opposition to the ban on the sale of puppies from Richmond pet shops.
