#### Staff Report

#### Origin

Gordon Jaggs started his employment with the City of Richmond as a Tree Preservation Coordinator in the Tree Bylaw Section on April 7, 2008 on a regular full-time basis.

Kirsten Lewis started her employment with the City of Richmond as a Tree Preservation Official on March 31, 2008 on a regular full-time basis.

#### **Analysis**

It would be appropriate during their investigations to provide these two employees of the City's Tree Bylaw Section with

- the ability to request personal information such as names and addresses;
- the ability to maintain continuity of the investigation and integrity of any evidence gathered;
- the ability to serve Court documents; and
- the ability to issue, as permitted, Municipal Ticket Information forms for infractions.

Under provisions of the Offence Act, for the purposes of the issuance of a violation ticket and / or service of summons in respect of an alleged offence under a bylaw of a Municipality, a Peace Officer includes Bylaw Enforcement Officers as appointed under the Police Act.

#### **Financial Impact**

None.

#### Conclusion

It is recommended that Gordon Jaggs and Kirsten Lewis be appointed as Bylaw Enforcement Officers, in accordance with Section 36 of the Police Act, for the purposes of the service of a summons and, as permitted, the issuance of tickets under the authority of applicable Municipal Bylaws.
