Submission of a Landscape Plan, prepared by a Registered Landscape Architect, to the satisfaction of the Direction of Development, and deposit of a Landscaping Security based on 100% of the cost estimate provided by the landscape architect. The landscape plan should comply with the guidelines of the Official Community Plan's Arterial Road Redevelopment Policy, and should include four (4) trees in the front yard [two (2) per future lot, minimum 5 cm calliper].
- 2. Registration of a flood indemnity covenant on title.

Surrounding Development	 The subject property is located on the north side of Williams Road, between Shell Road and No. 5 Road, and is surrounded on both the west and east sides by several newer single-family dwellings on smaller lots (i.e. R1/K or R1-0.6) created from original larger lots. The greater surrounding area consists predominantly of older character single-family dwellings on larger lots zoned Single-Family Housing District, Subdivision Area E (R1/E).
	 Recently, numerous similar redevelopment proposals along both the north and south sides this block of Williams Road have either been approved or are the subject of active applications.
	 The majority of lots on this block fronting Williams Road have redevelopment potential due to the existing lane system.

Staff Comments	 Background A Development Application Data Sheet providing details about the development proposal is attached (Attachment 2).
	Trees & Landscaping
	 A Tree Survey submitted by the applicant indicates that there are no bylaw-sized trees on the subject property or on adjacent property (Attachment 3).
	The applicant proposes to remove an undersized Cedar shrub from the front yard and an undersized Cedar hedge from the rear yard. The street trees located on City property fronting Williams Road are to be retained.
	 As a condition of rezoning, the applicant must submit a Landscape Plan, prepared by a Registered Landscape Architect, along with a Landscaping Security (100% of the cost estimate provided by the landscape architect) to ensure that the front yards of the future lots will be enhanced. In accordance with the guidelines in the OCP Arterial Road Redevelopment Policy, the landscape plan should include four (4) trees in the front yard [two (2) per future lot, minimum 5 cm calliper].
	Vehicle Access & Site Servicing
	 Vehicular access to the site at future development stage is not permitted to/from Williams Road as per Bylaw No. 7222. Access is to be from the existing rear lane and will not affect the City's street trees.
	 There are no servicing concerns or requirements with rezoning.
	 At future subdivision stage, the developer will be required to pay Development Cost Charges (City and GVS & DD), Neighbourhood Improvement Charges (for future lane improvements), School Site Acquisition Charge, Address Assignment Fee, and Servicing Costs.
	Flood Protection
	 In accordance with the Interim Flood Protection Management Strategy, the applicant is required to register a flood indemnity covenant on title prior to final adoption of the rezoning bylaw.
Analysis	This rezoning application complies with the City's Lane Establishment and Arterial Road Redevelopment Policies since it is a single-family residential redevelopment proposal with access to an existing operational rear lane. The Complete Proposal Pro
	The future lots will have vehicle access to the lane, with no access being permitted to or from Williams Road.

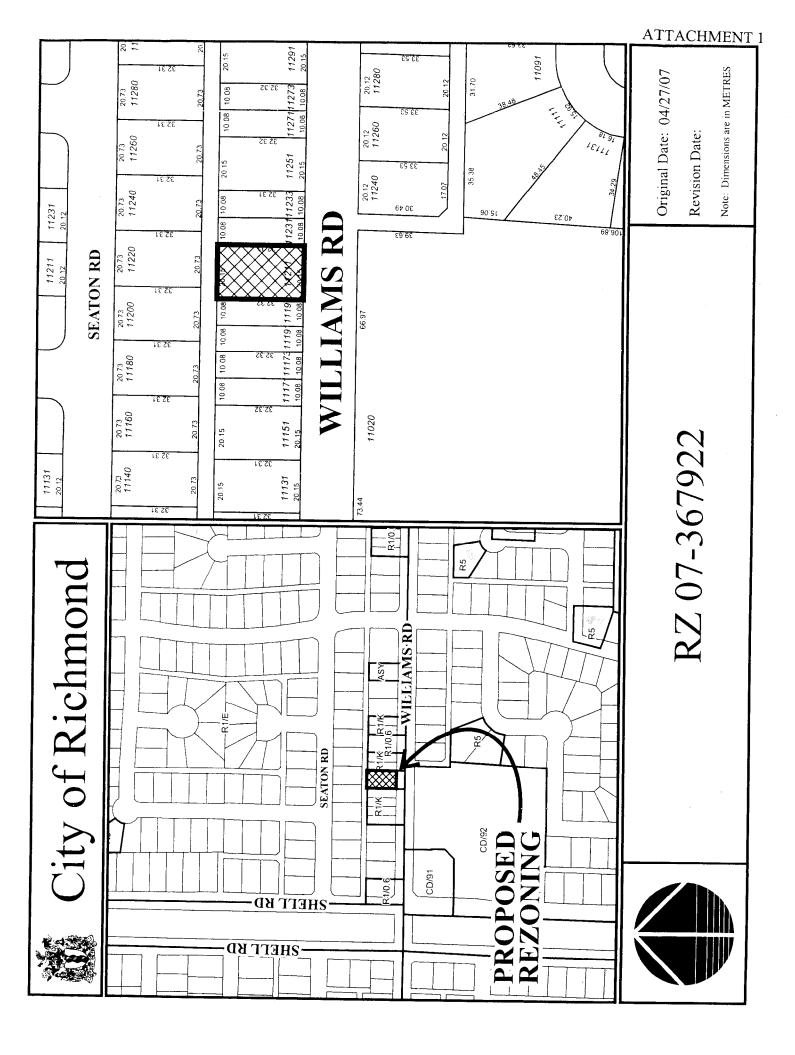

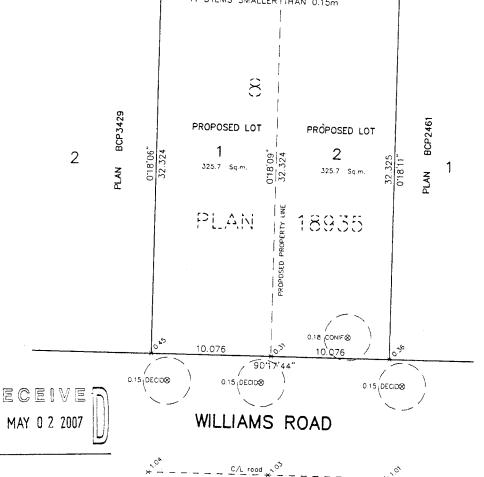

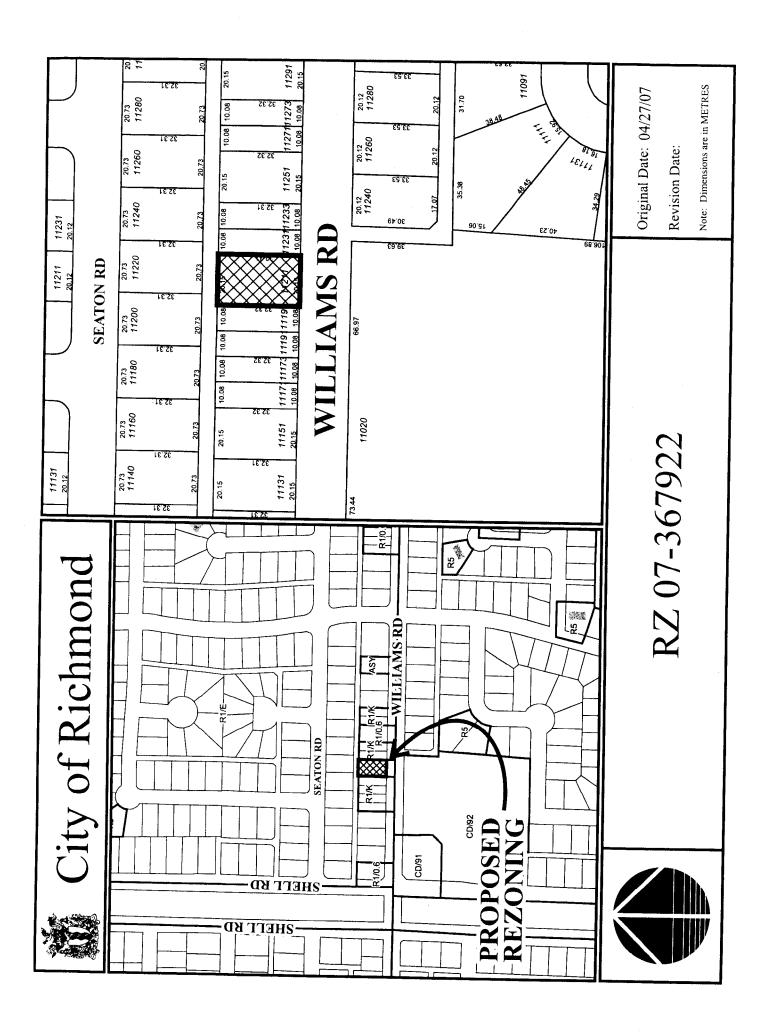

Richmond Zoning and Development Bylaw 5300 Amendment Bylaw 8258 (RZ 07-367922) 11211 WILLIAMS ROAD

The Council of the City of Richmond, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Zoning Map of the City of Richmond, which accompanies and forms part of Richmond Zoning and Development Bylaw 5300, is amended by repealing the existing zoning designation of the following area and by designating it SINGLE-FAMILY HOUSING DISTRICT (R1-0.6).
