APPLICANT: Kasian Architecture Interior Design and Planning Ltd.

PROPERTY LOCATION: 7820 Williams Road, Surplus City Lane Land, 10020 and

10060 Dunoon Drive

#### INTENT OF PERMIT:

- Permit the construction of a five-storey mixed-use commercial and residential building on 7820 Williams Road, 10020 and 10060 Dunoon Drive, and the associated surplus City lane land on a site zoned "Commercial Mixed-Use (ZMU19) Broadmoor". The proposed development consists of 1,891 m² ground floor commercial space, 59 residential apartment units, and 9 two-storey townhouse units on the western portion of the site; and
- 2. Vary the provisions of Richmond Zoning Bylaw 8500 to:
  - a) reduce the minimum setback from 7.5 m to 6 m for the 11.2 m height southwest stair to the third floor; and
  - b) increase the maximum height for buildings from 20 m to 21.5 m, limited to the elevator tower.

- 1.
