Comments	It is my fervent hope that ALL members of our city council will vote in favour of restricting home sizes on ALR lands, to 5382 square feet, or less. We are losing, and have lost, far too much precious farmland in Richmond, especially at a time when food security and sustainability are absolutely crucial. Regarding the issue of "intergenerational" homes - the average forty year old, 2200 square foot, Richmond home can easily accommodate a 2 bedroom basement suite, providing housing for another family. Homes certainly do not need to be 13,000 square feet to provide housing for an additional family; 5382 square feet, with the allowed addition of another building of 753 square feet, will be more than adequate to house multi-generational families!
