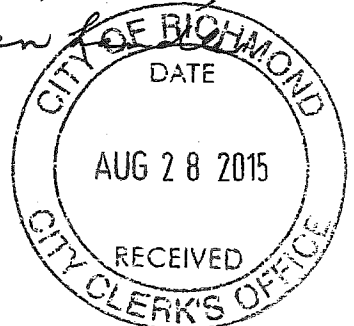
Dear Mr. Weber.
